

D-1. Weight Assessment and Counseling for Nutrition and Physical Activity for Children & Adolescents (WCC), BMI Percentile, 3-11 Years
















D-6. Weight Assessment and Counseling for Nutrition and Physical Activity for Children & Adolescents (WCC), Nutrition Counseling, Total









D-12. Childhood Immunization Status (CIS), MMR





























D-51. Statin Therapy for Patients With Cardiovascular Disease (SPC), Statin Adherence 80%, 21-75 Years (Male)






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D-52. Statin Therapy for Patients With Cardiovascular Disease (SPC), Statin Adherence 80%, 40-75 Years (Female)



D-63. Kidney Health Evaluation for Patients with Diabetes (KED), 18-64 Years






D-64. Kidney Health Evaluation for Patients with Diabetes (KED), 65-74 Years




D-65. Kidney Health Evaluation for Patients with Diabetes (KED), 75-85 Years





D-74. Follow-Up after Hospitalization for Mental Illness (FUH), 30-Day Follow-Up, 18-64 Years




D-75. Follow-Up after Hospitalization for Mental Illness (FUH), 30-Day Follow-Up, Total







D-76. Follow-Up after Hospitalization for Mental Illness (FUH), 7-Day Follow-Up, 6-17 Years




D-77. Follow-Up after Hospitalization for Mental Illness (FUH), 7-Day Follow-Up, 18-64 Years






D-78. Follow-Up after Hospitalization for Mental Illness (FUH), 7-Day Follow-Up, Total







D-79. Follow-Up After Emergency Department Visit for Mental Illness (FUM), 30-Day Follow-Up, 6-17 Years




D-80. Follow-Up After Emergency Department Visit for Mental Illness (FUM), 30-Day Follow-Up, 18-64 Years




D-81. Follow-Up After Emergency Department Visit for Mental Illness (FUM), 30-Day Follow-Up, Total




D-82. Follow-Up After Emergency Department Visit for Mental Illness (FUM), 7-Day Follow-Up, 6-17 Years






D-91. Follow-Up After High Intensity Care for Substance Use Disorder (FUI): 30-Day Follow-Up, 18-64 Years




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


D-95. Pharmacotherapy for Opioid Use Disorder (POD): 16-64 Years





D-114. Avoidance of Antibiotic Treatment for Acute Bronchitis/Bronchiolitis (AAB), 3 Months-17 Years




D-115. Avoidance of Antibiotic Treatment for Acute Bronchitis/Bronchiolitis (AAB), 18-64 Years






D-118. Use of Opioids at High Dosage (HDO) (Note that a lower score is better for this measure)




D-119. Use of Opioids from Multiple Prescribers (UOP) (Note that a lower score is better for this measure)








D-122. Risk of Continued Opioid Use (COU), At least 15 days, 18-64 Years (Note that a lower score is better for this measure)




D-123. Risk of Continued Opioid Use (COU), At least 15 days, Total (Note that a lower score is better for this measure)




D-125. Risk of Continued Opioid Use (COU), At least 30 days, Total (Note that a lower score is better for this measure)



D-126. Adults' Access to Preventive/Ambulatory Health Services (AAP), 20-44 Years






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D-127. Adults' Access to Preventive/Ambulatory Health Services (AAP), 45-64 Years








D-128. Adults' Access to Preventive/Ambulatory Health Services (AAP), 65+ Years




D-129. Adults' Access to Preventive/Ambulatory Health Services (AAP), Total












D-132. Initiation and Engagement of Alcohol and Other Drug Dependence Treatment (IET), Total: Initiation of AOD Treatment: 18+ Years



D-133. Initiation and Engagement of Alcohol and Other Drug Dependence Treatment (IET), Total: Engagement of AOD Treatment: 18+ Years












D-138. Use of First-Line Psychosocial Care for Children and Adolescents on Antipsychotics (APP), 1-11 Years




D-139. Use of First-Line Psychosocial Care for Children and Adolescents on Antipsychotics (APP), 12-17 Years




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


