

All About Washington's Electronic Business Solution (WEBS)

What is WEBS?

Washington's Electronic Business Solution (WEBS) is an internet based site hosted by the Department of Enterprise Services (DES). Many state agencies and educational institutions use WEBS to notify businesses of bidding opportunities. It will take most people about 5-10 minutes to sign up for WEBS. After your business is registered you will receive email notifications of bid opportunities.

Why is WEBS important?

The consolidated site shares funding opportunities with registered agencies. All funding opportunities related to Foundational Community Supports will be shared via WEBS. WEBS specifically eliminates the need to search multiple sites for funding opportunities.

How do I access WEBS?

- **Businesses** who want to register for WEBS can [sign up on the WEBS for Vendors Registration website](#).
- **Government entities or non-profits** can email webcustomerservice@des.wa.gov in order to get a WEBS account.

WEBS is our platform where businesses can [find current public agency solicitations for goods and services](#), including engineering, architectural consulting, construction and real estate leasing. Washington state agencies are required to post goods and services solicitations in the WEBS system.

Tips for using WEBS

- Check your email settings to receive WEBS notifications.
- You can add webcustomerservice@des.wa.gov to your safe senders list to ensure you receive important messages such as password changes, bid opportunities and award notifications.
- **Check for bid opportunities** regularly.
