# P5 Criteria Revisited

- 1. Community Informed** *Prioritizes approaches & ideas that strengthen child and family well-being, as shared by members of impacted communities and those that serve them*
- 2. Centers and Advances Equity** *Holds the promise to close the gaps in health access & outcomes measurably*
- 3. Realistic and Achievable** *Size & scope are appropriate for Washington's budget context policy landscape*
- 4. Capacity** *Implementation could be described and executed well and quickly*
- 5. Strengthens / Transforms** *Helps to build, sustain, or transform foundational systems*
- 6. Fit** *CYBHWG scope and avoids duplicating the work of other groups*

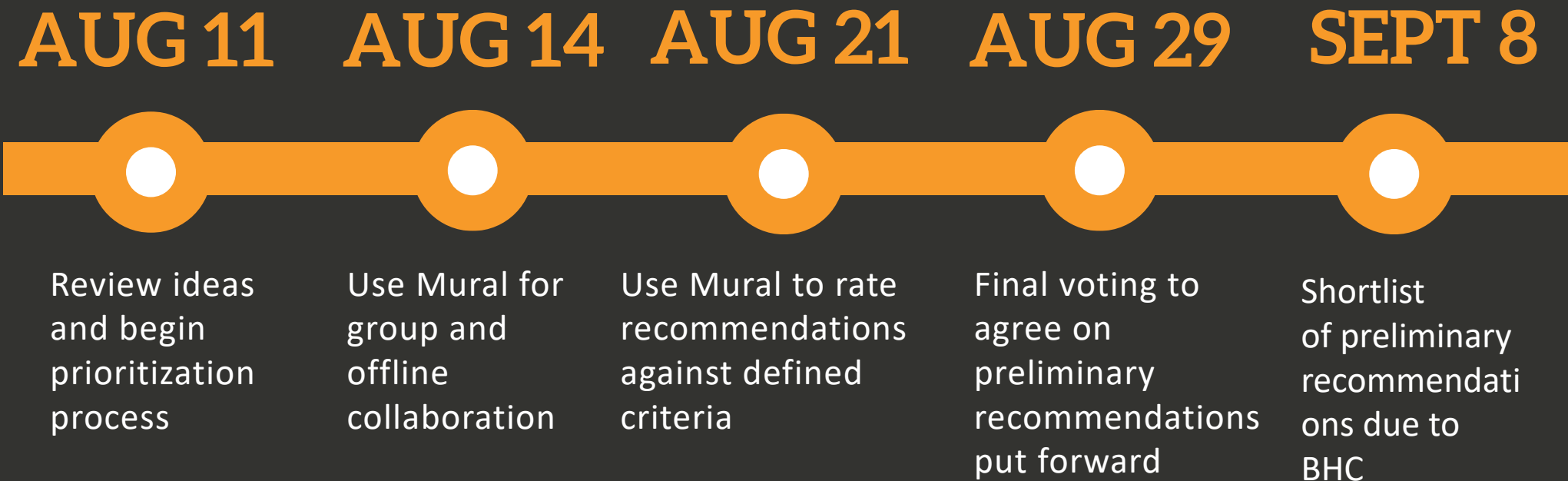
