State of Washington v. Shannon Blake

State v. Blake- 2016

Shannon Blake was arrested and convicted of Unlawful Possession of Controlled Substance

February 25, 2021

Supreme Court Decision ruled Controlled Substance Statute (RCW 69.50.4013) unconstitutional

May 13, 2021

ESB 5476 signed into law with an effective date of July 25, 2021.



Court system changes under ESB 5476

Revised Criminal Penalty Laws

- >Added the word "knowingly" to criminal possession laws- Sunsets July 1, 2023
- >Criminal penalty for possession of a controlled or counterfeit substance is now a misdemeanor
- > Prosecutors are encouraged to divert cases for assessment, treatment, or other services

Amendments to Chapter 10.31 (Warrants and arrests)

Directs police officers to refer individuals with substance use disorders to community-based programs, to include mobile crisis response services for youth and adults

Basic Law Enforcement Academy Training

- Training on how to interact with persons who display symptoms related to co-occurring substance use and mental health disorder
- The training will include best practices for referring individuals to treatment and recovery services, unique referral process for youth.







MOUD in Jails- Services Provided

- Opioid Use Disorder Screening, Clinical Opioid Withdrawal Scale (COWS) Screening and Assessment
- MOUD induction, offer all three FDA approved medications; buprenorphine, naltrexone and methadone when an OTP is available
- Screen for risk of acute withdrawal, offer MOUD treatment and other medications for withdrawal support
- Reentry Coordination/Transition Services: Schedule first community treatment appointment, transportation services, bridge medications
- Release kits that include naloxone and may include personal hygiene items, clothing
- Staffing: Medical, Case Management, SUDP, Peer Specialists, and Correctional officers





FY22 Recovery Residences TA update

- ESB 5476 directed HCA to contract with an organization with expertise in supporting efforts to increase and access to, and improve quality of, recovery housing and recovery residences.
- HCA contracted with Washington Alliance of Quality Recovery Residences for addressing the core components of the proviso

Deliverable	Description
Grievance Process	Create a standardized grievance process and procedures for the public and recovery residence peers to submit complaints and grievances.
Marketing Plan	Create and initiate a marketing plan to help educate state certified substance use disorder treatment providers about referring people to the Washington Registry of Recovery Homes.
Private Landlord Toolkit	Create a toolkit on how to partner with private landlords to increase recovery residences throughout the state
CBHA Toolkit	Create a toolkit for recovery residence operators and community behavioral health agencies to help provide Medicaid reimbursable services



Opioid Treatment Network- Contingency Management

- HCA directed to increase contingency management resources for opioid treatment networks that are serving people living with co-occurring stimulant use and opioid use disorder.
