

June 2015 ICD-10 Implementation

About ICD-10

Claims submitted with dates of service on or after October 1, 2015 must use the ICD-10 code set. The Agency will continue processing claims with the ICD-9 code set for claims with dates of service prior to September 30, 2015 regardless of date of submission. Claims submitted with the ICD-9 code set and dates of service on or after October 1, 2015 will deny with Remark Code M76 (missing or incomplete/invalid diagnosis or condition).

Provider and Managed Care Plan Testing

Washington Apple Health providers and managed care organizations are invited to participate in ICD-10 testing from July 6, 2015 to September 30, 2015 to ensure provider readiness. Participating providers will submit test claims using the ICD-10 codes to be sure that they will process correctly. The ProviderOne system will return standard EDI and PDF remittance advices for provider review, feedback, and correction. Please see the [ICD-10 Provider Testing Instructions](#) for details.

Claims Spanning 10/1/15
