**Purpose:**

This policy applies whenever coverage for a subscriber or a subscriber's dependent is terminated due to loss of eligibility.

**Policy:**

1. The Public Employees Benefits Board (PEBB) Program and employing agencies must terminate coverage as described in addendums 19-1A and 19-1B when a member is no longer eligible for enrollment in PEBB insurance coverage.
