SUBJECT: Fiscal Year 2004 PEBB Program Rates

The total employer-funding rate per active employee per month for the 2004 fiscal year is \$504.89 as established by Section 709 in ESSB 5404, the 2003-2005 operating budget. The new fiscal year (FY) 2004 employer funding rates for the Public Employees Benefits Board program will be effective July 1, 2003.

The funding rate includes \$4.13 to increase life insurance coverage due to the settlement of *Burbage et al. v. State of Washington*. There are no changes to the optional life or long term disability insurance rates at this time. For payroll purposes, the \$504.89 cost may be distributed as follows:

Medical	\$ 433.54
Dental	\$ 63.27
Life	\$ 5.38
LTD	\$ 2.70

COBRA and self-pay rates will remain the same until January 1, 2004, the beginning of the new "plan" year. You will receive revised rate sheets for self-pay and COBRA subscribers prior to open enrollment.
