# Guiding Legislation

- 2005 - Governor Gregoire's 5-Point Plan
- 2006 - E2SSB 5930: Blue Ribbon Commission Bill
- 2006 - 2SSB 5093: Children's Health Bill
- 2008 - E2SHB 2549: Patient-Centered Primary Care Bill (**KEY FOCUS**)

# HB 2549: Collaboratives

- DOH:
  - Develop common core elements of consistency among medical home providers
  - Provide standard measurement of outcomes
  - Promote adoption & use of efficient patient-centered care
  - Explore partnering with Washington Health Information Collaborative & Health Information Infrastructure Advisory Board as collaborative advances

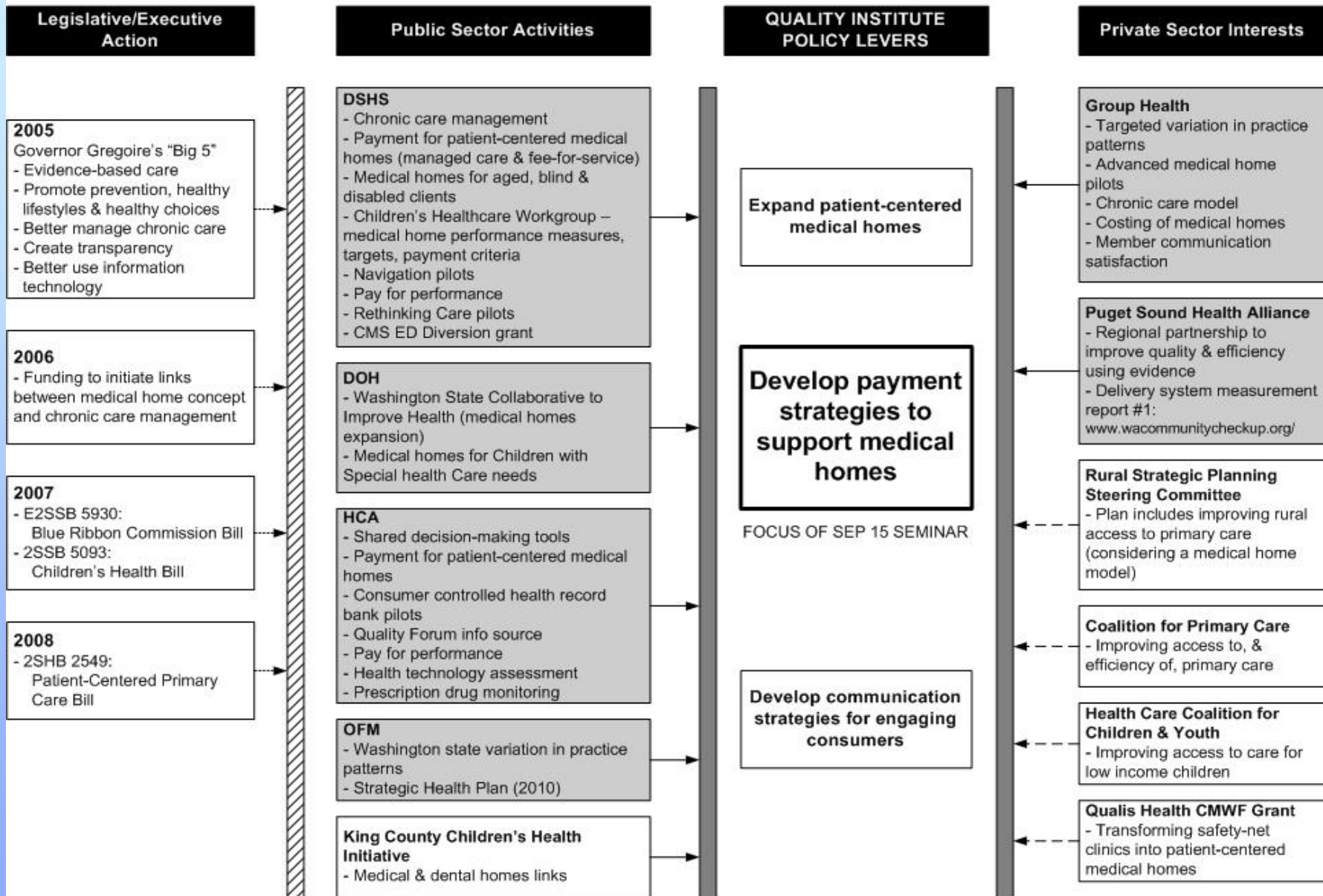
# HB 2549: Reimbursement Reform

- HCA & DSHS:
  - Alter reimbursement to support adoption of medical homes for state, federal, and third-party payers
  - Payment should promote improved patient outcomes by rewarding quality care
