Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 41.05.021, RCW 41.05.160

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: The agency plans to replace references to Retirement, Survivors, Disability Insurance (RSDI) and Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) with Old Age, Survivors, and Disability Insurance (OASDI). This change is to provide consistent references to the OASDI benefits provided under Title II of the Social Security Act in the agency's SSI-related income and resource rules for Medicaid. Both of these WACs refer to the same three types of benefits that the Social Security Administration (SSA) pays to eligible beneficiaries. A person who receives one or more of these cash payments is automatically related by category to one or more Medicaid eligibility groups. A common term for these SSA benefits is the OASDI program.
