**Agency:** Health Care Authority (HCA)

**Subject of possible rule making:** New Chapter 182-80 WAC, Primary Care Transformation Model (PCTM) Centralized Provider Certification; other related rules as appropriate.

**Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject:** RCW 41.05.021, RCW 41.05.160, and RCW 74.09.758

**Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish:** HCA is developing new rules for a centralized provider certification process as part of its implementation of the Washington Multi-payer Primary Care Transformation Model (PCTM). Providers statewide will be able to voluntarily participate in the model through the centralized certification process administered by HCA. Through this process, providers will be assigned a certification level from Level 1 to Level 3 based on their capacity to provide comprehensive, whole-person, primary care as delineated under the model. This certification process will provide a common measuring stick for gauging provider status under PCTM. During the course of this review, HCA may identify additional related changes that are required in order to improve clarity or update policy.
