

## Fact Sheet: Family Planning Services

## What is happening?

Beginning July 1, 2019, the programs formerly known as Apple Health (Medicaid) Family Planning Only Extension and Take Charge are undergoing significant changes. These changes affect both the names of the programs and, more importantly, service offerings for clients who use the programs.

## What are the changes?

#### **Program names**

The most noticeable change for clients and providers is simple a change of name:

#### Family Planning Only – Pregnancy Related

Formerly known as the Family Planning Only extension, this program serves recently pregnant women who lose Apple Health coverage after their 60-day post pregnancy coverage ends.

#### Family Planning Only

Formerly known as TAKE CHARGE, this program serves uninsured women and men seeking to prevent unintended pregnancy, and teens and domestic violence victims who need confidential family planning services.

#### Increased provider network

Historically, some of these services required that a client seek a specifically approved provider. With the July 1 changes, a client using either of the Family Planning Only programs can seek family planning services through any Apple Health provider.

#### Increased ease of enrollment

Clients can now apply for either of these benefits in person, by mail, phone, or fax.



# Eligibility for Family Planning Services

Family planning services in Apple Health for Pregnancy, Family Planning Only (FPO) and FPO – Pregnancy Related.
