Dear Provider,

Effective for claims with dates of service on and after April 1, 2014, Washington Apple Health (Medicaid), administered by the Health Care Authority (agency), is publishing a revised <u>Physician-Related Services/Health Care Professional Provider Guide</u> and updated <u>Physician-Related Services Fee Schedule</u>.

Note: The updated fee schedule may not be available until April 1, 2014. Check the agency's Fee Schedules website often until the updated fee schedule is available.

Major updates to the guide include:

- Blood and blood products Removed CPT 88240, Cell cryopreserve/storage from coverage list.
- Established patient visits Clarified billing requirement for CPT code 99211 to include signature and date by a qualified health care professional who provided the service.
- Expedited Prior Authorization (EPA) Removed requirement for prescriber and client to be enrolled in NEXUS program for EPA # 1300, injection, Romiplostim. This change is retroactive to dates of service on and after December 6, 2011, when AMGEN discontinued the NEXUS program.
- Independent advanced registered nurse practitioners (ARNPs) Added policy for a rate increase for independent ARNPs.
- Oral surgery coverage table Removed CPT codes 13150 and 15320. Added CPT codes 15275, 15278, 99242, 99244, 99252, 99254, and 99255.
- Nonemergency services out-of-state Added a policy section regarding nonemergency services provided out-of-state.
- Pre-/intra-/postoperative payment splits Removed payment split chart. Added hyperlink to Medicare Physician Fee Schedule (MPFS) online.
- PET Scans and MRI/MRAs Removed limit of one per day.
- Primary care providers Added policy section for a higher payment for certain primary care services.
- Screening, brief interventions, and referral to treatment (SBIRT) Removed limit of one (1) per client, per provider, per year for screenings.
- Smoking Cessation Clarified the process a client must follow when Tobacco Quit Line recommends a smoking cessation prescription.
