Dear Provider,

Retroactive to dates of service on or after April 1, 2014, Washington Apple Health (Medicaid), administered by the Health Care Authority (agency):

- Updated the Outpatient Prospective Payment System (OPPS) and Outpatient Hospital Fee Schedule with changes to Current Procedural Terminology (CPT®) code J7311.
- Updated the Outpatient Hospital Services Provider Guide with information on type of bill 141.

Fee schedule changes

Retroactive to dates of service on or after April 1, 2014, the agency covers the following CPT code with prior authorization:

CPT Code	PA	Short Description
J7311	PA	Fluocinolone acetonide implt
