

Infant Case Management (ICM) eligibility for leap years

This chart is for determining ICM eligibility during a leap year. Infants and their families are eligible for ICM the beginning of the month after the 60th day of birth in accordance with <u>WAC 182-533-0370</u>. The ICM eligibility beginning date varies depending on the number of days per month.

Birthdate	ICM period begins
January 1*	March 1
January 2-31	April 1
February 1*	April 1
February 2-29	May 1
March 1 or 2*	May 1
March 3-31	June 1
April 1 or 2*	June 1
April 3-30	July 1
May 1 or 2*	July 1
May 3-31	August 1
June 1 or 2*	August 1
June 3-30	September 1
July 1, 2, or 3*	September 1
July 4-31	October 1
August 1 or 2*	October 1
August 3-31	November 1
September 1 or 2*	November 1
September 3-30	December 1
October 1 or 2*	December 1
October 3-31	January 1
November 1 or 2*	January 1
November 3-30	February 1
December 1, 2 or 3*	February 1
December 4-31	March 1

^{*}Expedited prior authorization (EPA) required if ICM provided during first month of ICM eligibility.

Examples

• An infant is born on January 1 of a leap year. ICM eligibility begins March 1.

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- An infant is born on January 2 of a leap year. ICM eligibility begins April 1.
- An infant is born on February 9 of a leap year. ICM eligibility begins May 1.
