PHE End Date	Jon	LHJ MAC PHE-related program modifications will end beginning with Q323 (July 2023).	<p>The national COVID-19 Public Health Emergency (PHE) will end on May 11, 2023.</p> <p>HCA is working with the Steering Committee to begin winding down CMS-approved PHE-related program modifications, including:</p> <p>Q223 reverting to a 5-day RMTS response time.</p> <p>Q323 removing the direct charge option to claim for COVID and PHE-expenses for non-RMTS staff.</p> <p>Q323 activities related to infection control, surveillance and prevention will no longer be allowable MAC activity.</p> <p>Question: will there be updated RMTS coding guidance to help prepare staff for these changes?</p> <p>Response: updated guidance is being developed. In the meantime, MAC coordinators and participants are encouraged to review quick reference guides and the communicable disease program guide located in the training section of URMTS.</p>
