

## Update effective October 1, 2015

### How do I know if the person I am helping is Medicaid enrolled?

There are many methods to check whether a client is Medicaid enrolled. Most of these involve accessing ProviderOne. You may access ProviderOne to submit an enrollment inquiry using one of these methods:

Search for enrollment information via ProviderOne at <https://www.waproviderone.org/>

- Submit an electronic individual or batch 270/271 inquiry to ProviderOne
- Swipe the client services card using a magnetic card reader
- Call the Interactive ProviderOne Voice Response (IVR)

You may also check for client Medicaid enrollment through these methods:

- Use a Medical Eligibility Vendor to access information on your behalf
- Call a customer services representative at 1-800-562-3022

**IMPORTANT:** Though a client may be determined Medicaid enrolled for other programs, for a client to be considered Medicaid enrolled for purposes of the Medicaid Administrative Claiming (MAC) program a Recipient Aid Category (RAC) code from those listed on the next page must be indicated in the client's Client Eligibility Spans in ProviderOne. Identify the RAC code(s) assigned to the client and compare with those on the next page.
