

## Dental coverage available for COFA islanders

The Health Care Authority pays the monthly premiums and out-of-pocket expenses for Qualified Dental Plans for Compact of Free Association (COFA) islanders. COFA islanders include people from the Republic of the Marshall Islands, the Federated States of Micronesia, and the Republic of Palau.

## Am I eligible?

You are eligible if you have COFA Islander Health Care or if you have Medicare and:

- Are a COFA islander
- Live in Washington and,
- Have income less than 133% federal poverty level (see chart below)

You can submit an application for coverage:

November 1 through January 15

Washington Apple Health (Medicaid) was restored for individuals from the Federated States of Micronesia, the Republic of the Marshall Islands, and the Republic of Palau.
