

An Important Message from the Health Care Authority

The enclosed IRS Form 1095-B is for everyone who received minimum essential coverage through Washington Apple Health (Medicaid) for one or more months of the tax year.



Why am I getting this form and what do I do with it?

This tax form provides information we will send to the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) regarding your health coverage for the tax year. Whether you file taxes or not, keep this form for your records.

To find out if you have to file taxes or should file them even if it's not required, visit www.irs.gov or consult a tax professional.



Is all Apple Health coverage minimum essential coverage?

Not all Apple Health coverage is minimum essential coverage. Only individuals who had minimum essential coverage for the tax year will be listed on the 1095-B form.



What if information is incorrect or missing from my 1095-B?
