Summary of Revision

Emergency WAC filed 7/1/2015 to implement Community First Choice (CFC services. CFC is implemented effective 7/1/2015 as a new Long-term service and support. In addition, this is the final phase of the Medicaid WAC re-write to implement HB 1738 and Affordable Care Act changes to the Medicaid program. This filing corrects WAC references, updates definitions, and adds new sections to describe Hospice as a program, Roads to Community Living (RCL), and Program of all-inclusive for the elderly (PACE), and Medicaid Personal Care (MPC).
