


## How does suspension look in ProviderOne?

The easiest way to view a client's suspension status and dates of suspension is under the benefit inquiry screen (client search, benefit inquiry).

Example #1 Jails/Juvenile Rehabilitation facilities: Suspended-Inpatient Hospital Services Only plus Waiver Services

Open Suspended Benefit Package (SBP) – Institutionalized Dates (8500 jail Recipient Aid Category (RAC)) with open suspension RAC limiting coverage to inpatient hospitalizations and pre-release services up to 90 days before release.

From the Benefit Inquiry view:



**Note**: Remember while under "Suspended – Inpatient Hospital Services Only plus Waiver Services" RAC, the client's scope of coverage is limited to a set of pre-release services up to 90 days before release and inpatient hospitalizations for over 24 hours throughout the incarceration.

To determine whether a client is eligible for reentry services up to 90 days before release in a carceral facility that participates in the Reentry Initiative, please refer to Reentry Policy and Operation Guide.


To determine whether a client is eligible for CAA-only service in a carceral facility that are not a part of Reentry Initiative, please refer to Reentry Policy and Operation Guide.

## **Example #2 Department of Correction: Suspended-Inpatient Hospital Services Only plus Waiver Services:**

Open Suspended Benefit Package (SBP) – Institutionalized Dates (8000 DOC - Prisons RAC) with open suspension RAC limiting coverage to inpatient hospitalizations and pre-release services up to 90 days before release.

From the Benefit Inquiry view:




**Note**: Remember while under "Suspended – Inpatient Hospital Services Only plus Waiver Services" RAC, the client's scope of coverage is limited to a set of pre-release services up to 90 days before release and inpatient hospitalizations for over 24 hours throughout the incarceration.

To determine whether a client is eligible for reentry services up to 90 days before release in a carceral facility that participates in the Reentry Initiative, please refer to Reentry Policy and Operation Guide.

To determine whether a client is eligible for CAA-only service in a carceral facility that are not a part of Reentry Initiative, please refer to Reentry Policy and Operation Guide.

## **Example #3 Suspended - Inpatient Hospital Services Only:**

Open Suspended Benefit Package (SBP) – Institutionalized Dates (8500 jail RAC) with open suspension RAC limiting coverage to inpatient hospitalizations only for **state only clients with state-funded RAC**. From the Benefit Inquiry View:



**Note**: Remember while in a suspended status, the client's scope of coverage is limited to inpatient hospitalizations only.
