- Classic Medicaid Individuals who are age 65 and older, have blindness or a disability, or are on Medicare.

Our report a change campaign reminds clients to update their contact information, so they receive important notices about their coverage. These messages can be used now through one year after the end of the PHE.

Report a change campaign messaging

- If you are age 65 and older, have blindness or a disability, get Medicare, and are receiving health care coverage through DSHS: if your contact information has changed, update your info at washingtonconnection.org, by calling 1-877-501-2233, or in person at your local Community Service Office.
- Make sure your contact information is up to date! If you are receiving health care coverage through DSHS and are age 65 and older, have blindness or a disability, get Medicare, and have moved in the last 3 years, update your contact information. Stay informed on important updates about how to keep your coverage.
 - Visit washingtonconnection.org, call 1-877-501-2233, or visit your local Community Service Office to update your contact information today.
- Are you are receiving health care coverage through DSHS and are age 65 or older, or have blindness
 or a disability? We want to reach you with important coverage updates. If your contact information
 has changed visit washingtonconnection.org, call 1-877-501-2233, or visit your local Community
 Service Office to update your current phone numbers, email, and mailing address in our records
 today.

Renew your coverage campaign messages

- Be on the look-out for your health care coverage eligibility review. Those who are age 65 or older, have blindness or a disability, can renew online at washingtonconnection.org, get assistance over the phone at 1-877-501-2233, or in person at your local Community Service Office.
- Did you know? If you are age 65+, have blindness or a disability, get Medicare, and received a notice to renew your health care coverage with DSHS, you can complete your eligibility review online at washingtonconnection.org. No need to wait on the phone or go to an office.
- Keep an eye out for your health care coverage eligibility review notice from DSHS! Renew your coverage and make sure your contact information is up to date at washingtonconnection.org.
