

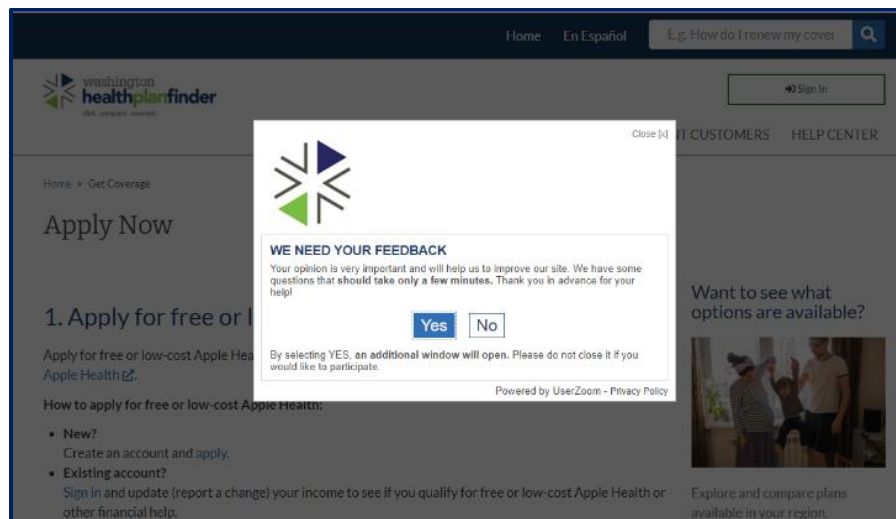
Washington Healthplanfinder – November 2021 System Release

System release outage

The Washington Healthplanfinder is scheduled to go live on Thursday, November 18, 2021, at 7:30 a.m. PST. There is not a planned outage for this release.

Customer survey

- As of November 1, 2021, a modal appears asking individuals to participate in a survey about their experience with using the Washington Healthplanfinder. The survey is available to individuals the first time they visit the *Apply Now* page on Washington Healthplanfinder, and if yes is selected, the survey will come up at the end of their time in the system.



Reporting other health insurance

- A message will be added to the *other health insurance coverage question* stating an individual does not need to report their other insurance coverage when it is ending within 60 days.

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Username and special character

- If an individual tries to use special characters in their username, an updated message will appear informing them to *use only letters (A-Z), numbers (0-9) and periods (.) in your username.*

Correspondence update

- The correct Washington Administrative Codes (WAC) will appear in the *Eligibility Results correspondence (EE015)* when children are denied Washington Apple Health due to other minimum essential coverage, or when an individual is denied coverage due to being eligible under a different Apple Health program.
