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Legislation

Substitute Senate Bill 5883 (2017) required Health Care Authority (HCA) to:

Contract (through competitive procurement process) with licensed dental health plans or managed health care plans to provide dental services through a managed care delivery model

Health Care Authority's Goals

Increase access to comprehensive dental care for Washington Apple Health (Medicaid) clients

2017 utilization: Only 22% of adults and 56% of juveniles utilized services

Improve oral health outcomes

Project Status

Announced Apparently Successful Bidders (ASBs):

Dentegra/Delta

Amerigroup

MCNA

Began implementation activities with ASBs to ensure compliance with federal requirements

Finalized client/provider communication

Implementation on hold while budget impact is fully assessed

Update: Other Dental Initiatives

Medicaid Transformation Project

Several Accountable Communities of Health working to increase access to oral health services and ensure that oral health included in whole person care

Oral Health Connections pilot project

Provide additional oral health services for adults with diabetes and adult pregnant women

Access to Baby and Child Dentistry (ABCD) program

Expand program to serve children with disabilities through their 12th birthday (available now to all children through age 5)

Dental Health Aide Therapists (DHAT) tribal program – SSB 5079

Allow DHATs to perform routine and preventive services at lower costs to tribes, in tribal settings
