

Providers who work together to improve your health

Under UMP Plus–UW Medicine ACN, network providers—your doctors, nurses, and other health care providers—work with you to improve your health. Together, they consider the whole picture of your health to enhance the care you receive. You choose your own primary care provider within UMP Plus–UW Medicine ACN’s network, and you can self-refer to specialists and other providers in the network.

Access to comprehensive services

UMP Plus–UW Medicine ACN has the most comprehensive services in the Puget Sound region, with more than 6,500 primary and specialty care providers, 18 hospitals, and more than 1,300 clinics and urgent care facilities.

You can view the network’s provider directory online by visiting UMP’s website at ump.regence.com to confirm if a specific provider is in the UMP Plus–UW Medicine ACN network.

You save money when you use network providers, so if you have specific providers or facilities you want to use, make sure they’re in the network before you enroll.

Convenience

- + Schedule appointments with network providers, get clinic information, connect with a virtual clinic at no cost to you, and get other services through a single phone number.
- + Access a 24/7 nurse line.
- + Enjoy expanded hours for many primary care and urgent care network providers across UMP Plus–UW Medicine ACN’s network.

Lower health care costs

- + Primary care office visits at no cost to you when you see a core network primary care provider (or a naturopath from the support network).*
- + No prescription drug deductible.
- + Premiums and a medical deductible that are lower for UMP Plus–UW Medicine ACN compared to some of the other UMP plans.
- + An out-of-pocket limit of \$2,000 per person or \$4,000 per family for covered benefits.

*Related services, like x-rays or labs that you may receive during these office visits, may be subject to the medical deductible and coinsurance.
