We previously sent you the 2018 Evidence of Coverage (EOC), which provides information about your coverage under our plan. This letter notifies you of an error in your EOC document. Changes to your 2018 EOC

Where you can find the error in your 2018 EOC	Original information	Corrected information	What does this mean for you?
Page 54, in “Outpatient prescription drugs” provision.	The EOC did not state that cost shares do not apply to the out-of-pocket maximum under “Outpatient prescription drugs.”	There should be an asterisk next to “Outpatient prescription drugs” to indicate that outpatient prescription drug cost shares do not apply to your out-of-pocket maximum.	Any cost shares you pay for covered outpatient prescription drugs do not apply to your out-of-pocket maximum.
