Purpose: This policy clarifies when <u>an</u> employer group <u>or board members of school districts or</u> <u>educational service districts may terminate their participation may terminate in Public Employees</u> <u>Benefits Board (PEBB) insurance coverage</u> mid-year.

WAC 182-08-245(5) The employer group or board members of school districts and educational service districts must maintain participation in PEBB insurance coverage for at least one full year. An employer group or board members of school districts and educational service districts may only end participation at the end of a plan year unless the authority approves a mid-year termination. To end participation, an employer group or board members of school districts must provide written notice to the PEBB Program at least sixty days before the requested termination date.

Policy:

- 1. The PEBB plan year ends December 31 of each year.
- 2. The authority will consider, but not limit, requests for <u>a</u> mid-year terminations if the request meets one of the following criteria and is received within the required timeframe:
 - a. An employer group <u>or board members of school districts and educational service</u> <u>districts</u> requests to end participation as of the end of their fiscal year.

- b. An employer group requests to end participation for a collective bargaining unit effective the date of the bargaining unit agreement.
- 3. Coverage prospectively terminates will be terminated prospectively the first of the month following the agreement.
