**Purpose:**

This policy applies whenever coverage for a subscriber or a subscriber's dependent is terminated due to loss of eligibility, or because a subscriber or dependent was enrolled when they were not eligible for coverage.

**Policy:**

1. The Public Employees Benefits Board (PEBB) Program and employing agencies must terminate coverage as described in Addendums 19-1A and 19-1B when a member is no longer eligible or was not eligible for enrollment in PEBB insurance coverage.
