Purpose:

This policy applies whenever a subscriber requests an enrollment change or election change outside of the Public Employees Benefits Board (PEBB) annual open enrollment.

Policy:

- 1. The PEBB Program and employing agencies must use Addendum 45-2A when processing a subscriber's request to change his or her enrollment or his or her dependent's enrollment under a group health plan (medical or dental).
- 2. The PEBB Program and employing agencies must use Addendum 45-2A when processing an employee's request to change his or her election under the state's salary reduction plan.
- 3. A PEBB subscriber must use Addendum 45-2A to determine if he or she is allowed to change enrollment in a group health plan (medical or dental) or change an election under the state's salary reduction plan.
- 4. A PEBB subscriber must provide evidence of the event that created the special open enrollment (SOE). Addendum 45-2A provides examples of documents that provide valid evidence of the event that created the SOE.

Exception: Evidence of the event that created the SOE is not required for a premium payment plan change due to dependent loss of eligibility.
