

SEBB by the numbers

Demographics

- 295: Number of school districts
- 3: Number of educational service districts (ESDs) with represented employees
- 12: Number of charter schools
- 150,000: Estimated number of school employees eligible for SEBB benefits
- 150,000–200,000: Estimated number of dependents eligible for SEBB benefits
- 97,000: Estimated number of children eligible for SEBB benefits
- **75,434:** Certificated staff by FTE in 2015-16
- **63,923:** Classified staff by FTE in 2015-16
- 74: Percentage of school employees on west side of state
- 25: Percentage of school employees on east side of state
- 78.5: Percentage of school employees in urban schools
- 21.5: Percentage of school employees in rural schools
- 70: Number of school districts participating in Public Employees Benefits Board (PEBB) Program before implementation of SEBB Program
- 5: Number of ESDs participating in PEBB before implementation of SEBB
- 7,000: Approximate number of school employees enrolled in PEBB who will enroll in SEBB
- 25: Percentage of school employees enrolled in PEBB before implementation of SEBB

Eligibility

- 630: Number of work hours anticipated for school employee to be eligible for SEBB benefits
- 17.5: Average hours per week needed to reach 630 work hours per school year, based on a 10month year

Money

- 3:1: Ratio of school employee's premium for self, spouse or state-registered domestic partner, and children to employee's premium for self only
- \$0: Amount eligible school employees will pay in premiums for dental, vision, basic life and accidental death and dismemberment, and basic long-term disability insurance
- \$900 million: Amount in Gov. Jay Inslee's budget to cover premiums for eligible school employees and dependents

Carriers, providers, and plans

- 3-7: Estimated number of medical carriers each school employee will have to choose from, depending on the county they live in
- 7: Number of carriers expected to provide medical coverage
- 3: Number of carriers expected to provide dental coverage
- 3: Number of carriers expected to provide vision coverage

SEB Board

- 9: Number of SEB Board members, representing different segments of K-12 and public policy
- **58:** Number of resolutions passed by the SEB Board as of Jan. 22, 2019
