## **SEBB Program Administrative Policy 19-1**

## Purpose:

This policy applies whenever coverage for a subscriber or a subscriber's dependent is terminated due to loss of eligibility, or because a subscriber or dependent was enrolled when they were not eligible for coverage.

## Policy:

The School Employees Benefits Board (SEBB) Program and SEBB Organizations must terminate coverage as described in addendums 19-1A and 19-1B when a member is no longer eligible for enrollment in SEBB insurance coverage.
