Get rewards for living well

SmartHealth is Washington State's voluntary wellness program that supports whole person well-being. Keeping up with preventive care, screenings, and vaccinations

Staying on top of your preventive care is one of the best things you can do for your health. When you check in with your health care providers regularly, you're more likely to catch concerns before they turn into major problems. If you don't already get an annual physical to check things like blood pressure and cholesterol, that's a great place to start. It's also important to talk with your provider about screenings, like checking for breast cancer, prostate cancer, diabetes, or colorectal cancer.

Keeping up with well-child visits is an important part of their health care. During these routine visits, your provider can evaluate your child's development, discuss necessary vaccinations, and address any potential health issues. Young children need several vaccinations to help their immune system develop protection against serious diseases. As they grow older, children need additional doses of certain vaccines to ensure they're fully protected.

Your UMP plan covers many preventive care services at no cost to you. Be sure you see a provider in your network. Doctor On Demand

Doctor On Demand is a virtual care service that gives you access to primary care and behavioral health providers 24 hours a day, seven days a week. It is a good option to consider when you need medical attention, but not emergency room or urgent care. Members can connect in minutes with doctors face-to-face through a smartphone, tablet, or computer via the website or Doctor On Demand smartphone application. All UMP members are eligible for this service except for UMP Plus members (UMP Plus members have access to similar services through their networks). Get medical advice 24/7 through Advice24 nurse line

UMP's nurse line, provided by Advice24, offers 24/7 access to registered nurses who can provide immediate support for everyday health issues and questions that otherwise might lead to unnecessary doctor or emergency room visits. They can also serve as an early warning system to flag health conditions before they become serious. Advice24 does not replace 911 for emergencies. Find the right behavioral health care for you with Quartet

UMP has partnered with Quartet to make it easier for you to get the behavioral health care you need. Quartet's navigation team works alongside your primary care provider to find an in-person or telemedicine behavioral health specialist that is in your plan's network, has availability and offers an array of services, including mental health counseling, substance use disorder, and psychiatry services. There is no cost to participate in the program; you will pay the standard rate for behavioral health services. Get support for controlling and preventing diabetes

Preventing diabetes

Eligible UMP members may enroll in the Diabetes Prevention Program through Omada Health.

This program combines the latest technology with ongoing support to help you build healthy habits that last. You'll get a professional health coach, a wireless smart scale, and a supportive peer group. Controlling diabetes

Eligible UMP members may participate in the Diabetes Control Program. Regence case managers are trained to help you reduce the risk of complications with diabetes by tracking and controlling blood sugar, cholesterol levels, blood pressure, and weight in a series of quarterly consultations. You may find out if you qualify for the program by visiting your primary care provider for a blood sugar laboratory test. Your primary care provider will tell you if you meet criteria once the laboratory results are available. If you qualify for the Diabetes Control Program, you may self-refer by calling 1-866-543-5765. Low- to no-cost knee replacement, hip replacement, and spine care

If you qualify for services, the UMP Centers of Excellence (COE) Program covers single knee and single hip replacement surgery, and spine care evaluation and/or surgery for low to no cost. This program is available for all UMP members except those enrolled in UMP Plus and UMP members enrolled in Medicare as their primary coverage. Medicare and UMP Plus members have access to covered services related to joint replacement and spine care outside of this program. Quit tobacco and nicotine for good

UMP offers access to programs and coaches to help you live tobacco-free, including:

- Certain nicotine replacement therapies and products.
- In-person counseling related to tobacco cessation.
- Quit for Life tobacco cessation program.
- Smokefree Teen program for UMP members ages 17 and under.
