## A few details about your prescription drug benefit:

- ID card. Always show the pharmacist your UMP ID card when buying your prescriptions. You use the same card for both medical services and prescription drugs. If you are already enrolled in UMP and are not switching plans, you can keep using your current UMP ID card. Only new UMP members and members who switch from UMP Classic or UMP CDHP to UMP Plus (or vice versa) will receive a new ID card. UMP Plus members have a different ID card, but use the same pharmacy network. Call UMP Customer Service at 1-888-849-3681 (TRS: 711) to order more ID cards.
- Online resources. Visit www.hca.wa.gov/ump/find-drugs to find a network pharmacy, search the UMP Preferred Drug List, get an estimate of what you'll pay, and view potential savings. You can also log in to your pharmacy account to review your past prescription drug claims or learn about drug information and drug interactions.
- Mail-order pharmacy. Postal Prescription Services (PPS) saves you money on select prescription drugs.

- Choice90Rx network pharmacies. If you are taking an ongoing prescription drug and purchase between an 84-day supply to 90-day supply, you may be able to save money by going to a Choice90Rx network pharmacy. Some Choice90Rx network pharmacies are Bartell, Costco, CVS Pharmacy, Fred Meyer, Haggen, Safeway, and Savon. To compare drug prices and see a complete listing of Choice90Rx network pharmacies, visit www.hca.wa.gov/ump/find-drugs or call Washington State Rx Services.
- Specialty pharmacy. Purchase your specialty medications only through Ardon Health.
- Vaccine. If you use a network vaccination pharmacy, you can get many immunizations at no cost to you. UMP covers vaccines according to the immunization schedules set by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), including flu shots and other common vaccinations such as whooping cough (pertussis), tetanus, shingles, cervical cancer, and meningococcal.

Note: UMP doesn't cover vaccines for travel or employment. Call Washington State Rx Services for a complete list of network vaccination pharmacies or covered vaccines.
