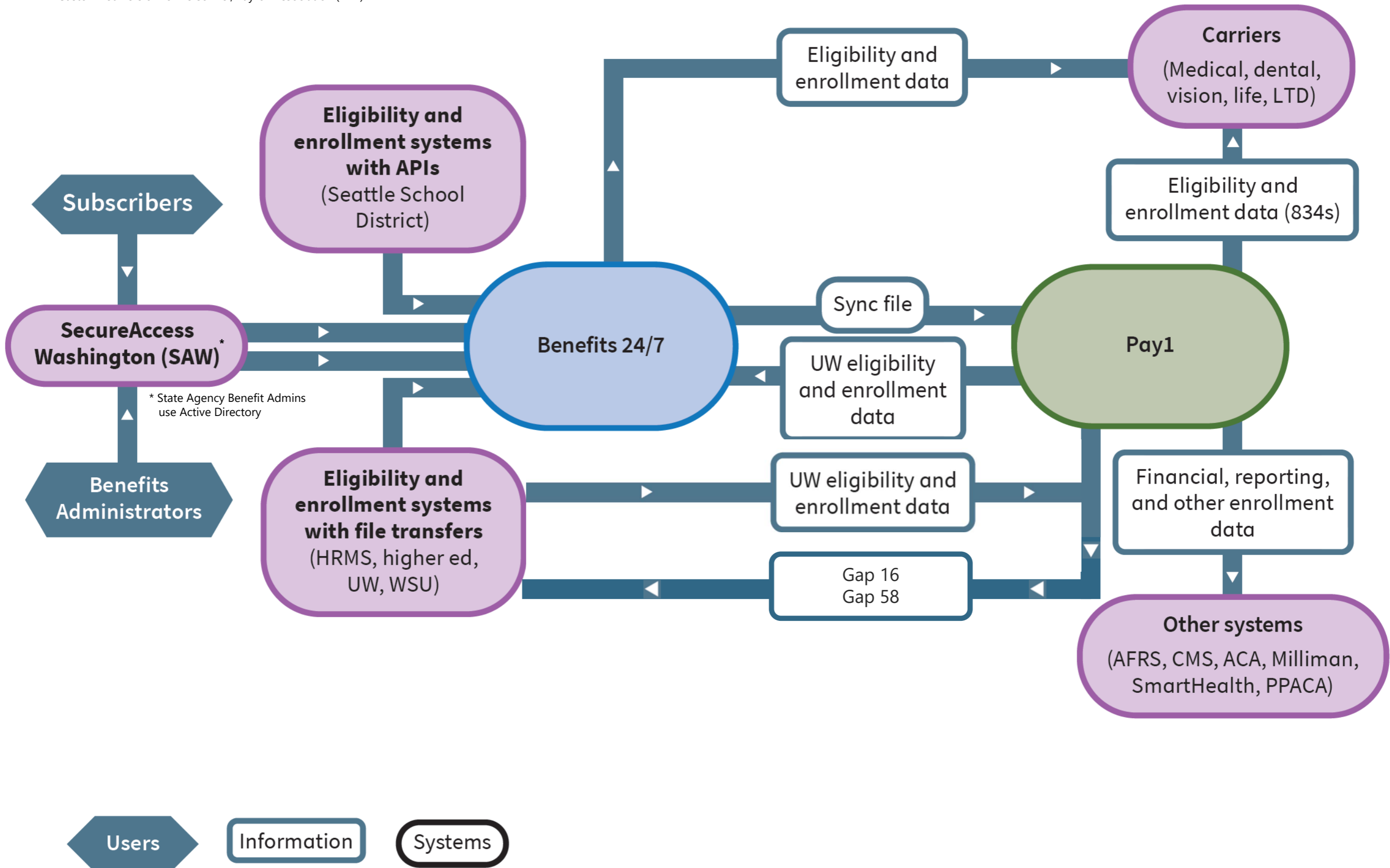


PEBB and SEBB systems current state

Long Description: This graphic is a flowchart that shows the current state of PEBB and SEBB program systems and how the data syncs between the systems, specific to HRMS.

The chart begins on the left, showing that subscribers and benefits administrators log into SecureAccess Washington (SAW) and then access Benefits 24/7. An asterisk next to the SAW text notes that State Agency Benefit Admins use Active Directory.

The next section shows that eligibility and enrollment systems with APIs (such as Seattle School District) do not access SAW and instead log into Benefits 24/7.

Additionally, eligibility and enrollment systems with file transfers (such as HRMS, higher ed, UW, and WSU) also do not access SAW and instead log into Benefits 24/7.

From Benefits 24/7, eligibility and enrollment data is sent to Carriers for medical, dental, vision, life, and LTD.

Benefits 24/7 also syncs the data and sends eligibility and enrollment data to our legacy Pay1 system, which in turn can send data to Carriers

Additionally, UW can send eligibility and enrollment data directly to Pay1, which then sends the data to Benefits 24/7.

From Pay1, the data can be sent through Gap 16 and Gap 58, and back to the eligibility and enrollment systems of HRMS, higher ed, UW, and WSU.

The far right of the graphic shows that from Pay1, financial, reporting, and other enrollment data is sent to other program systems, such as AFRS, CMS, ACA, Milliman, Navia, SmartHealth, and PPACA.
