Agency: Health Care Authority, Washington Apple Health

Subject of possible rule making: WAC 182-505-0120, Washington apple health breast and cervical cancer treatment program (BCCTP) for women-Client eligibility, and other rules as appropriate.

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 41.05.021, 41.05.160
