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Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish:	
The agency is amending these rules to comply with new federal regulations under 42 CFR 440 requiring that physicians document the occurrence of a face-to-face encounter (including through the use of telemedicine) within reasonable timeframes when ordering home health services for Medicaid eligible clients. The agency is also aligning these rules with the new final federal rules to clarify that home health services are not restricted to clients who are homebound or to services furnished solely in the home. During the course of this review, the agency may identify additional changes that are required in order to improve clarity or update policy.
