The way I am reading the RFP, I think the answer is no, but my clinical leadership asked me to affirm that. There may be interest from some off our other affiliates in the MultiCare Behavioral Health Network to start up PACT services in places we are not currently providing them. I wanted to check if we are eligible to apply to start a new program in a different location if we are already currently operating a PACT program. Thanks in advance for any guidance you might be able to provide.	The funding is available for expanding PACT across the state by adding three new teams. Agencies can operate multiple teams in the same region or in other regions as long as the teams function on their own and are distinct teams. This means they cannot share direct staff, must follow full fidelity modeling, and bill separately.
