



CMS EHR Certification ID

An Eligible Professional (EP) or Eligible Hospital (EH/CAH) who participates in the EHR Incentive Program must obtain a CMS EHR Certification ID from CHPL. The CMS EHR Certification ID must be submitted as part of the attestation process for either the Medicare or Medicaid incentive program.

CMS EHR Certification ID is a 15-digit alphanumeric string that represents a product or combination of product(s) in CHPL
