

## Washington State Common Measure Set on Healthcare Quality and Cost – Health Plan Level Results

Results for these 9 measures MUST come from HCA and the health plans (they are the only ones with the data/capability to produce results) – we knew this in December 2014 when the Common Measure Set was approved. Results will not be available at the medical group level. We are working with data sources to make results available for the state and/or county/ACH when possible – varies by measure.

Health plan-level results for these 18 measures (for the commercially insured population) can come from the Alliance, but they would be calculated based on incomplete data for that health plan since the plans do not currently submit all of their data to the Alliance. Therefore, it is strongly recommended that all six commercial health plans submit CY 2014 health plan-level results to the Alliance (commercial population as submitted to NCQA) for the following measures to enable public reporting of health plan-level results:
