The purpose of Amendment four (4) is to revise HCA's responses to Applicant questions posted in Amendment three (3). The questions below are amended as follows:

#	RFA Section	Bidder Question	HCA Response
2.	1.1	Are private companies such as corporations or LLC's eligible to bid on this RFA?	Yes - public or private non-profit organizations are eligible to apply.
7.	1.2	If we are receiving SOR funding at a Single- Site rate, can we apply as a Multi-Site rate?	If you currently have CBO SOR funding, you may apply for DMA and MHPP funding, but not SOR funding. If you have CPWI SOR funding, you may apply for DMA, MHPP, and SOR funding.

#	RFA Section	Bidder Question	HCA Response
17.	Exhibit(s) G	Does implementation include the costs to transport students to and from programs?	Include the costs in your Application Action Plan. Refer to the allowable costs description included in the RFA Exhibit G funding packets to shape your response. Each funding source has specific funding requirements that may be negotiated with applicants. Per RFA Section 1.7, Definitions: Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Super Circular 2 CFR 200.501 and 45 CFR 75.501, "Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards" for additional detail. Each funding source has specific funding requirements. We reserve the right to negotiate final budgets with Apparent Success Applicants in order to meet funding requirements per source.
