State Opioid Response (SOR) Grant

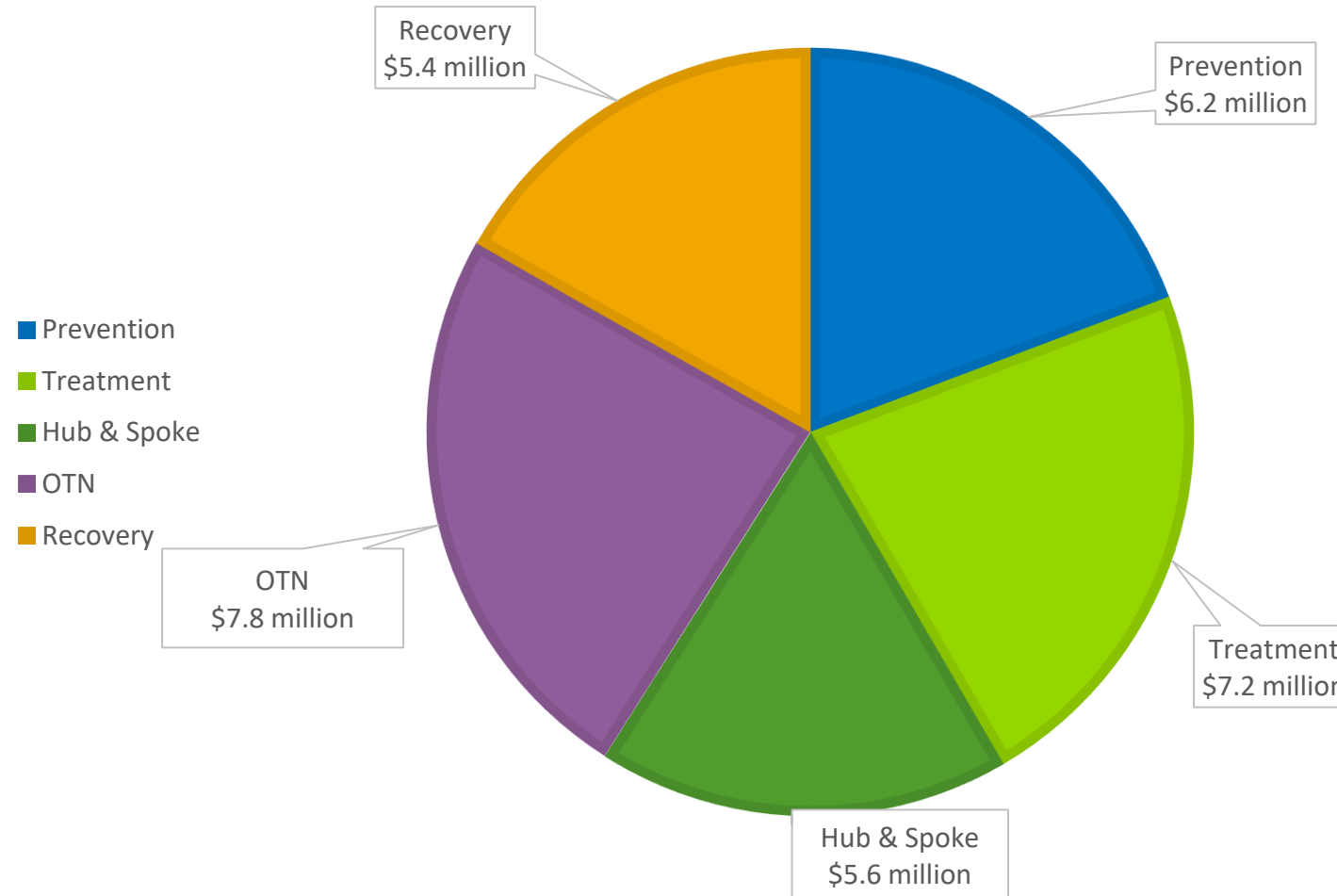
Overview

- ▶ The State Opioid Response (SOR) grant addresses reducing unmet treatment need and opioid overdose related deaths through prevention, treatment and recovery activities for opioid use disorder (OUD).
- ▶ The grant aims to increase access to Medications for Opioid Use Disorder (MOUD) using the three FDA-approved medications for the treatment of opioid use disorder (OUD).

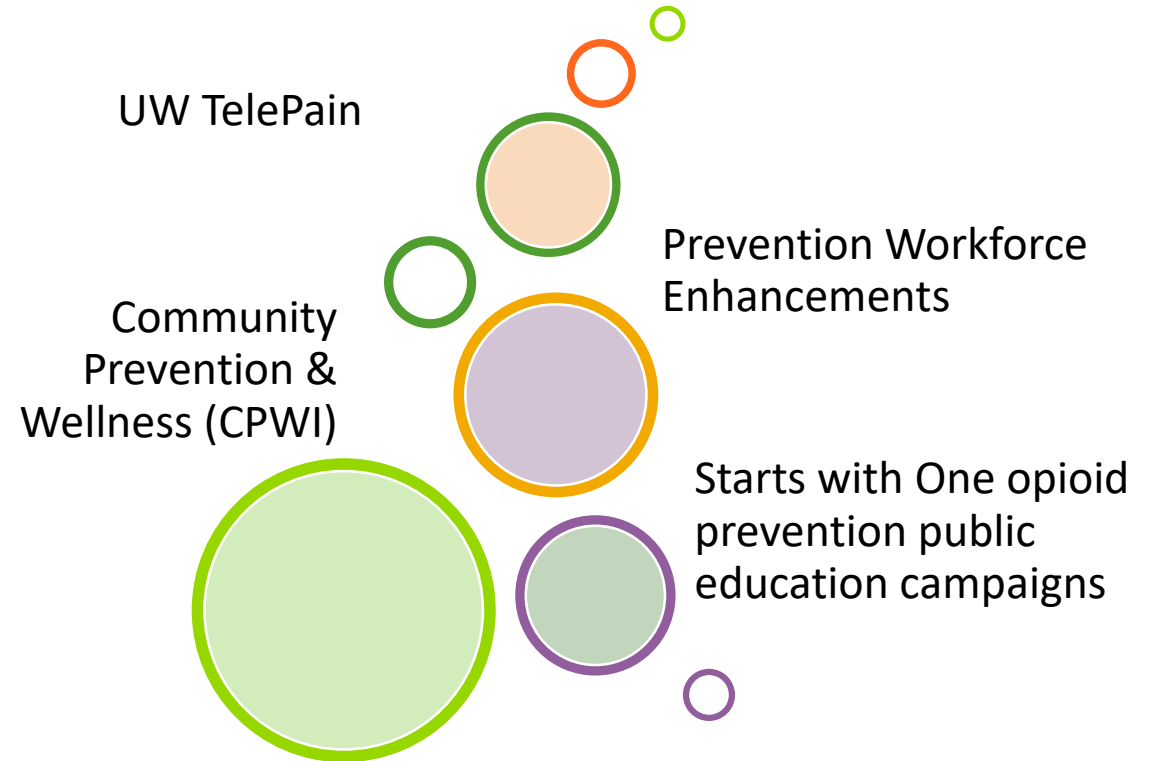
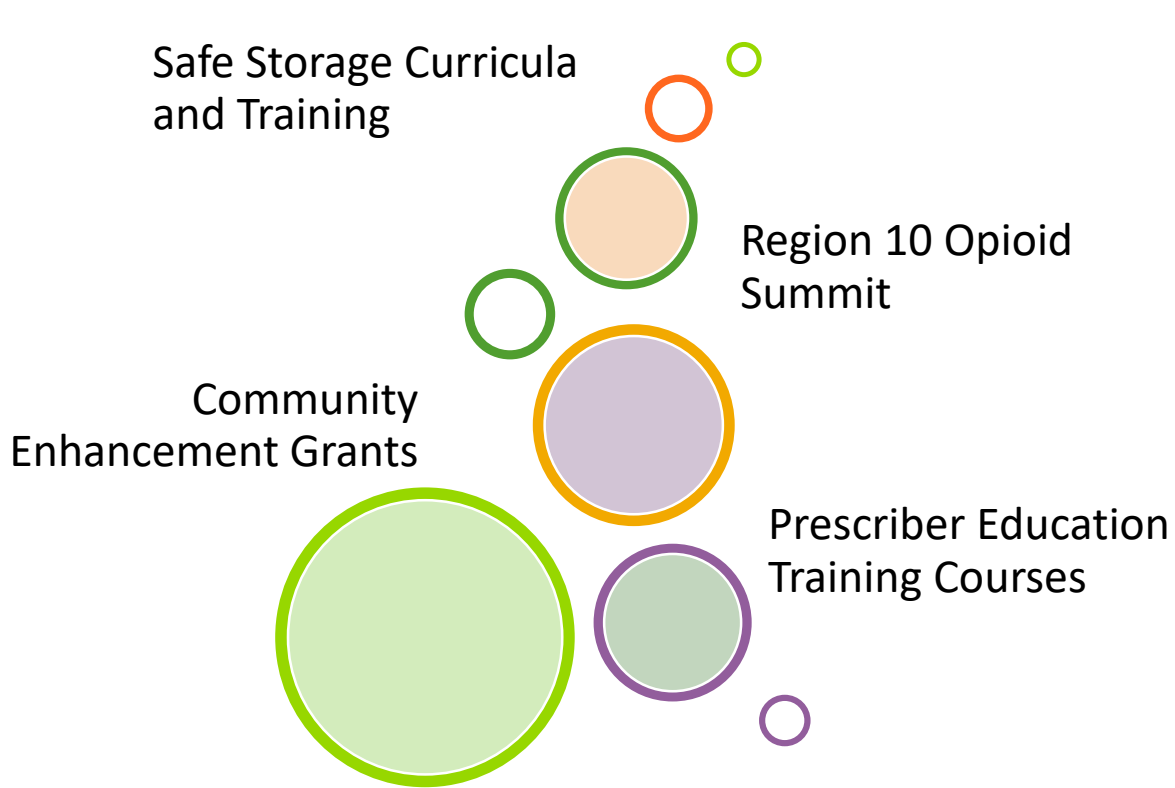

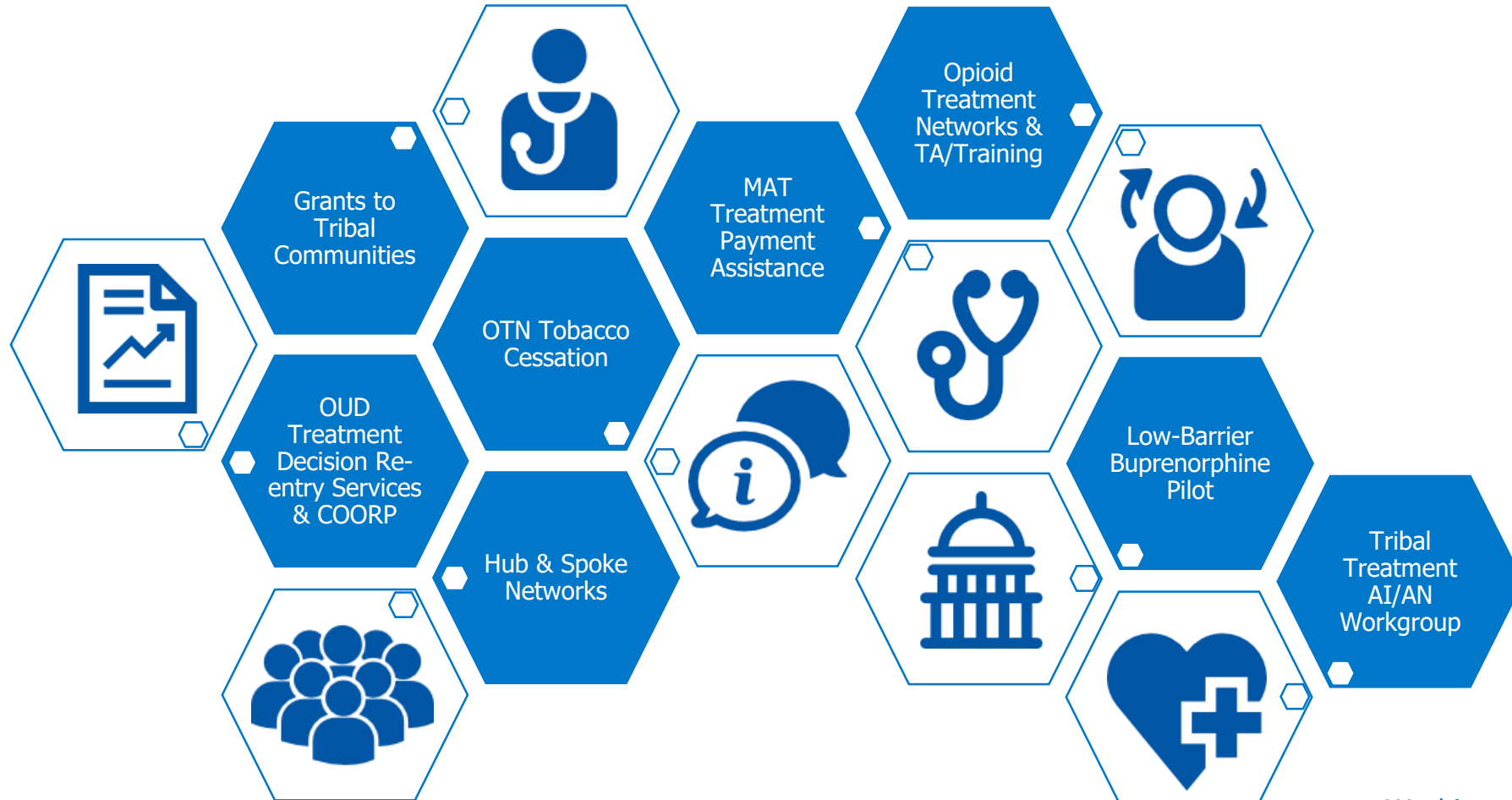
