

Average BHO Mental Health Encounters per WISe Service Month





The service location summary excludes encounters from Greater Columbia prior to 4/1/2016, as the data is unavailable for that time period. Both the service location and service modality summary exclude data from North Central after 12/31/2017 and Southwest after 3/31/2016, as they are unavailable in the BHSS data system. Because a small number of clients participating in the Address Confidentiality Program are included in statewide totals but not in regional breakdowns, numbers do not sum to statewide totals.
