### DBHR updates: Recovery Support Services

- Chief HCA is hosting the 4<sup>th</sup> annual Outreach Academy June 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> in Tacoma, WA. This event is intended to provide a foundation of training for homeless outreach workers across the state. Registration will open in early April.
- The Health Care Authority and the Department of Health are hosting an informational <u>listening session</u> to discuss Peer Specialist changes related to SB 5555, establishing Certified Peer Specialist and Trainees.
  - ▶ The enhanced 80-hour Certified Peer Specialist training has launched. This training is for people who want to move forward in the new profession of Certified Peer Specialist and will also qualify people as Certified Peer Counselors who bill Medicaid with an agency affiliated counselor credential at a licensed community behavioral health agency.
  - ▶ The Certified Peer Specialist "GAP" training is now available on the Peer Support Talent Learning Management System. This LMS training is for current Certified Peer Counselors who want to move forward in the new profession of Certified Peer Specialist with the Department of Health.

#### DBHR updates: Diversion and Reentry

- Housing and Recovery though Peer Services (HARPS) officially switched over from Excel Spreadsheets to the Program Data Acquisition Management and Storage (PDAMS) system for data submissions
- The two HCA contracted Peer Respites are reporting an increase in referrals with more consistent, higher levels of occupancy



## DBHR updates: Adult Substance Use and Treatment Section

#### Clark County Jail Certified as an Opioid Treatment Program

► Clark County Jail recently became the first jail in Washington state licensed as an Opioid Treatment Program (OTP). This program is partially funded with State and opioid abatement settlement dollars and was recently featured on *Think Out Loud* an Oregon Public Broadcasting and is featured on Apple Podcasts, as well. #### Safer Supply Work Group Listening Session

- ▶ Health Management Associates (HMA), in partnership with HCA and the Washington State Department of Health (DOH), is hosting a community meeting to discuss policy recommendations created by the WA Safer Supply Workgroup. HMA will review recommendations from the workgroup, educate attendees on safer supply programs, and hold a listening session.

#### Opioid Intervention Court Pilot

- ▶ DBHR has partnered with Cowlitz County Superior Court and Walla Walla County Superior Court to embed a peer within Therapeutic Court programs to help support individuals in obtaining access to Medications for Opioid Use Disorder (MOUD).

#### Behavioral health legislation

- SB 5361: Requiring HCA and OIC to delay adoption of the updated ASAM Criteria, 4<sup>th</sup> edition, until January 2028.
- ▶ HB 1287: Addressing the disclosure of health information for care coordination.
- ► E2SHB 1432: Improving access to appropriate mental health and substance use disorder services
- **2SHB 1427:** Concerning certified peer support specialists
- SHB 1706: Aligning the implementation of application programming interfaces for prior authorization with federal guidelines.

#### E2SHB 1218

- Governor Inslee's request legislation re: Trueblood
- Concerning persons referred for competency evaluation and restoration services.

#### SUD Prevention and Mental Health Promotion

SHB 1066: Creating a data dashboard to track use of regulated substances.

## Corrections and issues impacting justice-involved individuals and reentry

- SSB 5139: Concerning reentry council.

▶ E2SSB 5098: Restricting the possession of weapons on the premises of state or local public buildings, parks or playground facilities where children are likely to be present, and county fairs and county fair facilities.

#### **Crisis services**

- SHB 1811: Enhancing crisis response services through coresponse integration and support.
- **E2SHB 1813:** Concerning the re-procurement of medical assistance services; including the re-alignment of behavioral health crisis services for Medicaid enrollees
