### Overview of BHAC

#### **History**

- Title XIX of the Public Health Services Act (42 U.S.C. 300x) mandated that all states establish a State Mental Health Planning and Advisory Council.
- The Washington State Behavioral Health Advisory Council (BHAC) previously known as the Mental Health Planning Advisory Council (MHPAC) was formed in 2014. The change occurred when Washington State started integrating all behavioral health services to include mental health, substance use disorder and problem gambling.

#### Mission

The Behavioral Health Advisory Council mission is to advise and educate the Division of Behavioral Health and Recovery for planning and implementation of effective behavioral health services by promoting individual choice, prevention, and recovery in Washington State.
