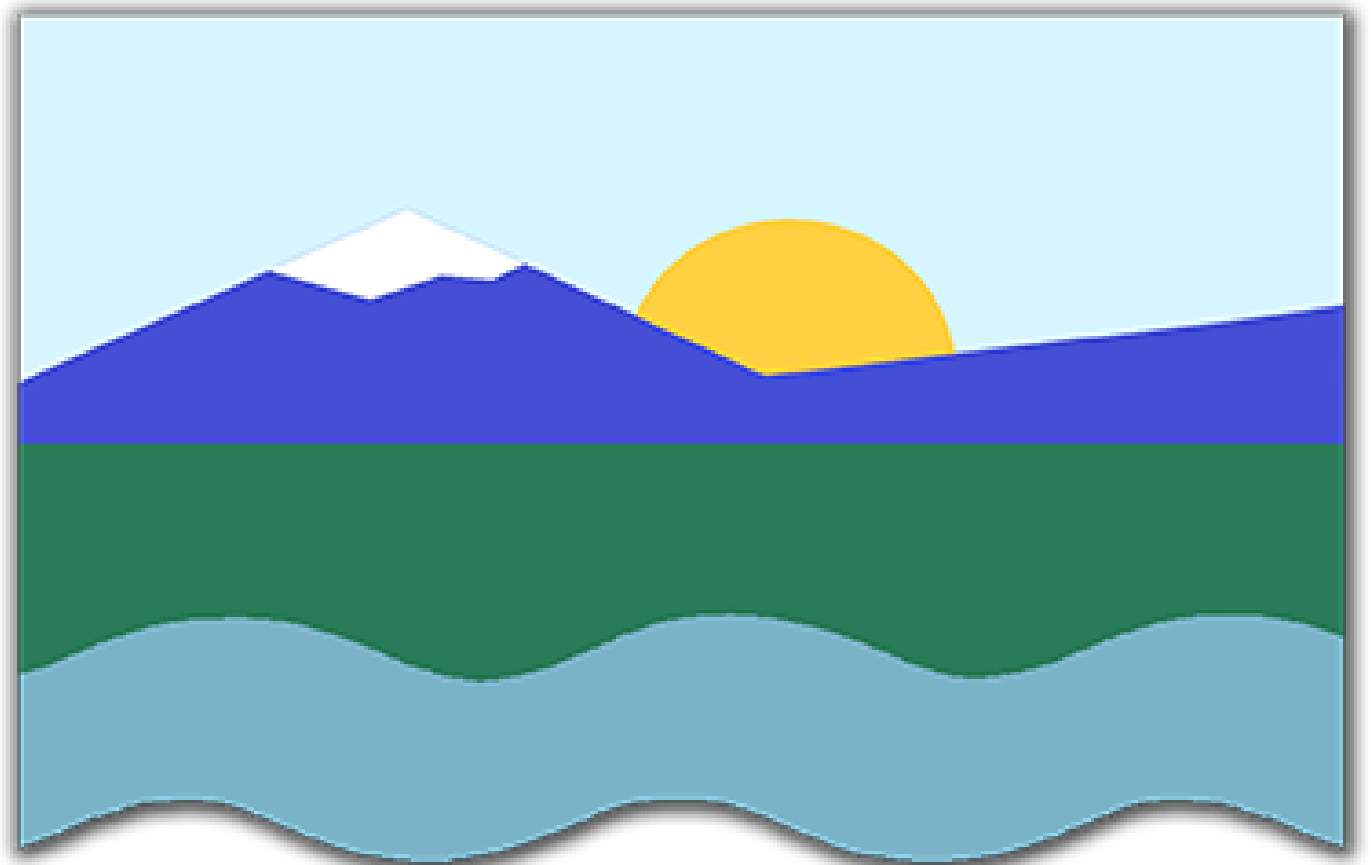

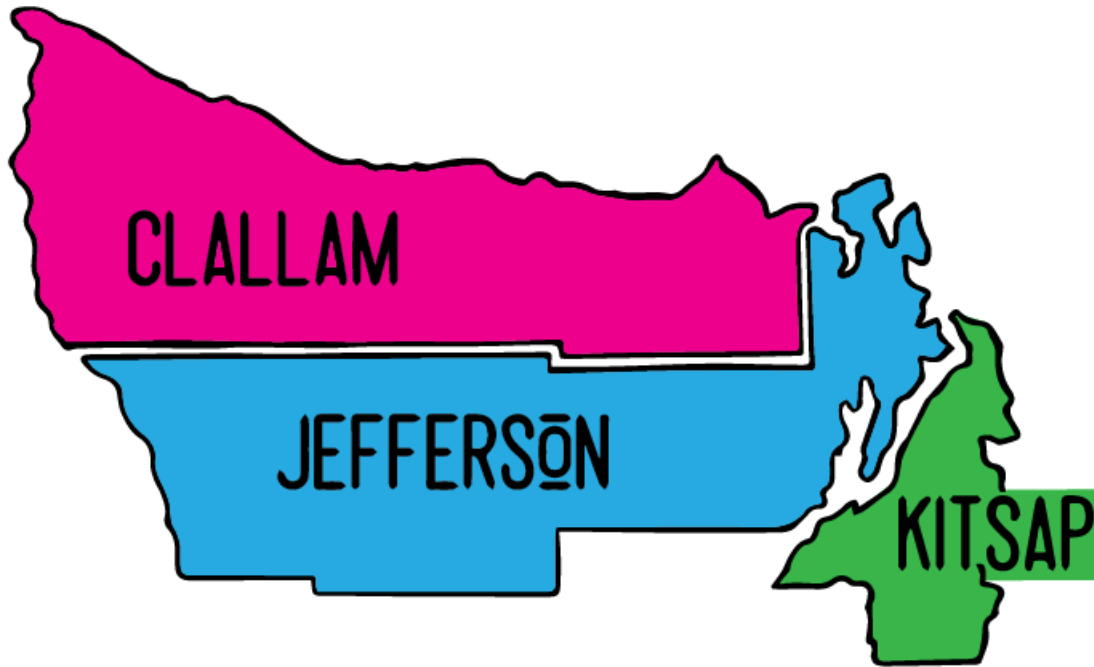

# SALISH BHASO ADVISORY BOARD



- 11 Members: 3 from each county and 2 Tribal Representatives
- Members are appointed by the Salish BHASO Executive Board
- 51% must be individuals with lived experience or their family members

# ADVISORY BOARD ROLE

- Review and make recommendations to the Salish BHASO Executive Board regarding Behavioral Health Plans, contracts, and subcontracts for services implemented by Salish BHASO.
- Participate in the Request for Proposal (RFP) processes that implement services within Salish BHASO.
- Serve as liaisons within the Salish region, engage in events to support behavioral health, and provide advocacy and education to and on behalf of their community.

# HISTORICAL BOARD PRIORITIES

## Overarching Priorities:

- Integrative Behavioral Health Continuum: Emphasizing peer-directed services as part of a comprehensive behavioral health model.

## Mental Health Priorities:

- Housing support services and access to affordable housing
- Childcare services
- Children's intensive services (including inpatient care)
- A full spectrum of intensive services (including peer respite services, stabilization, and inpatient services)

## SUD Priorities:

- Housing support services and access to affordable housing
- Childcare services
- A full spectrum of intensive services (including withdrawal management, stabilization, and residential services)
