There is an Evaluation and Quality Assurance section to which all are invited. Kathy has sent documents to the reviewers including the committee charter, membership and Measures of Statewide Performance.</p> <p>Raetta raised a question about the survey just received at RSNs. Provider feedback has been very negative – that the reasons for the survey weren’t clearly articulated; response options were not inclusive or provide for additional input.</p> <p>Bridget and Barb presented a brief review of how the original proxy was created (can be found as part of the Settlement Agreement on the DBHR Children’s Behavioral Health website) and now the analysis to update it is proceeding.</p>	<p>Please tell Kathy if you plan to attend so that she can organize the response to specific questions. Lin mentioned the requirement for a WISE community collaborative to review data.</p> <p>Jake asked a question re tracking referrals to WISE. RAJR is developing consistent processes for WISE referrals and wants to know if any information re same is required and if so, if there is a requirement re how this information is communicated.</p>	<p>The WISE Implementation and Quality Management Plans as well as the newly released FYSPRT Manual all have specific information re these processes.</p> <p>https://www.dshs.wa.gov/bhsia/division-behavioral-health-and-recovery/family-youth-and-system-partner-round-tables-fysprts The emphasis is that we're learning as we go and as best practices are developed they will be shared. Local communities must decide the best place for data review to avoid duplication/rework.</p> <p>This information is required per the WISE QMP. There is no consistent tool developed. RAJR asked to use whatever works for them – perhaps an excel spreadsheet with client identifiers (sent securely) for QI process related to access and engagement.
