Support Washington's **community health transformation** by building a regularly refreshed, **interactive dashboard tool**

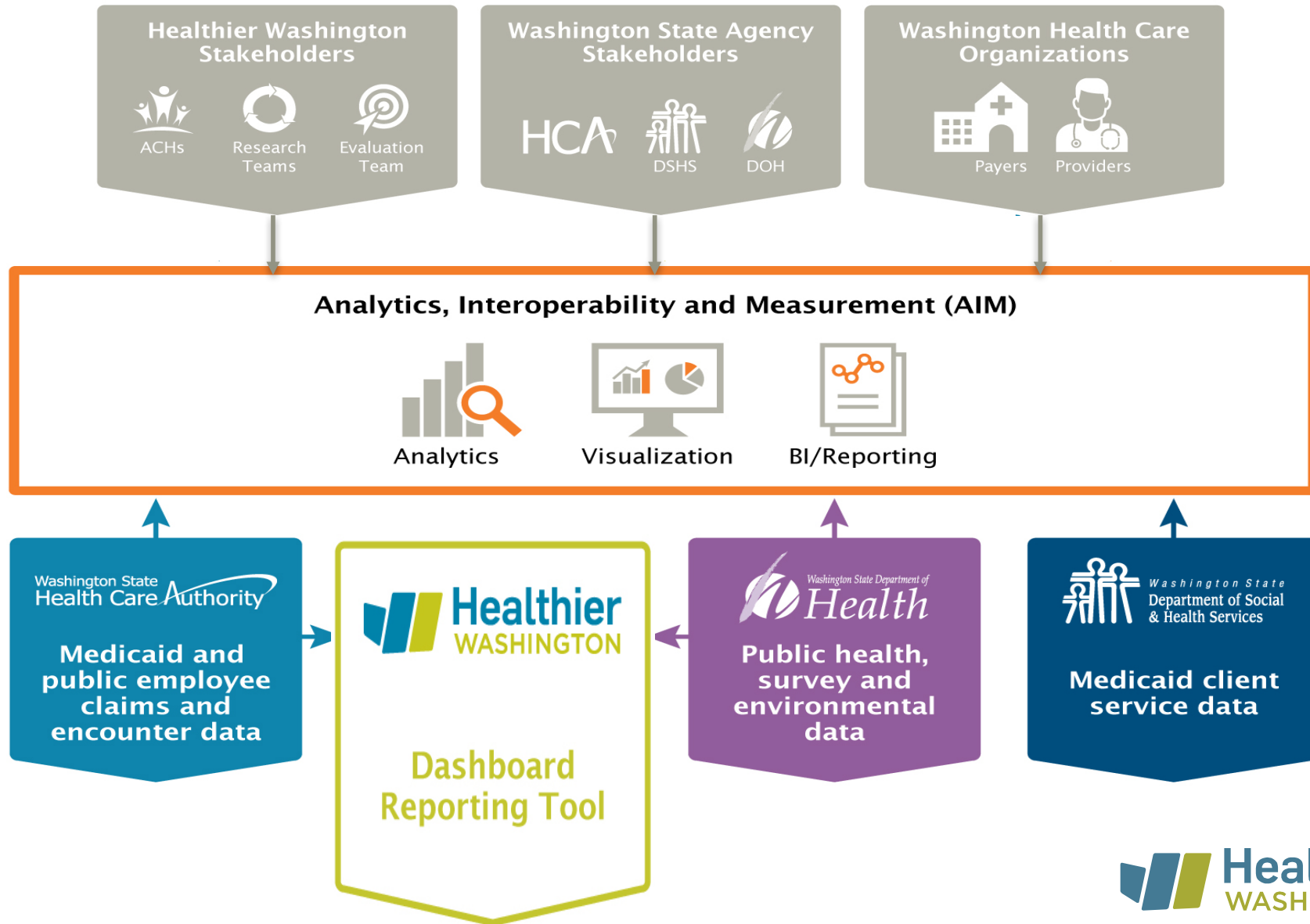
A business intelligence and analytics tool that is **interactive** and the information within it will be **regularly refreshed to monitor metric change over time**

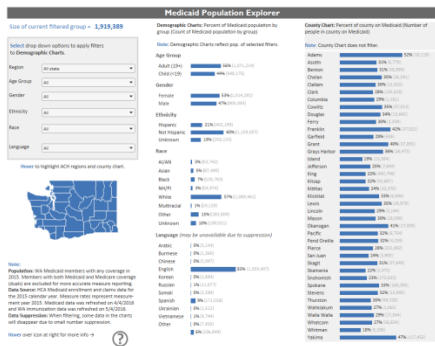

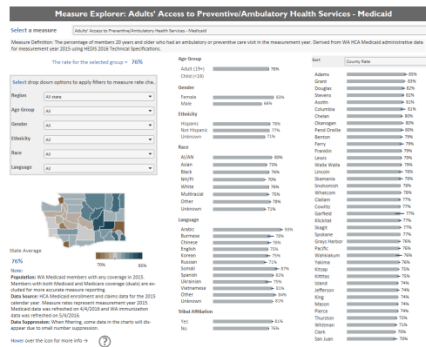
HEALTHIER WA DASHBOARDS - ABOUT THE DASHBOARDS

The third release of the Healthier WA Dashboards in **March 2017** will include five distinct dashboards that allow regions to explore data on populations and measures for Washington State.

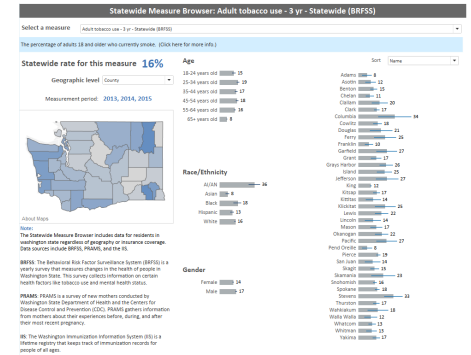

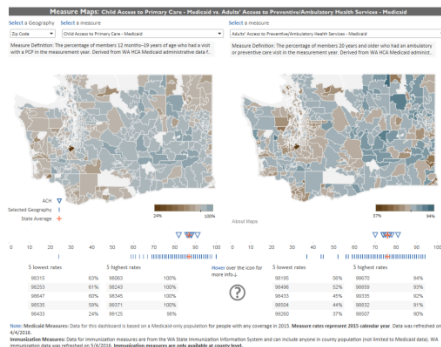

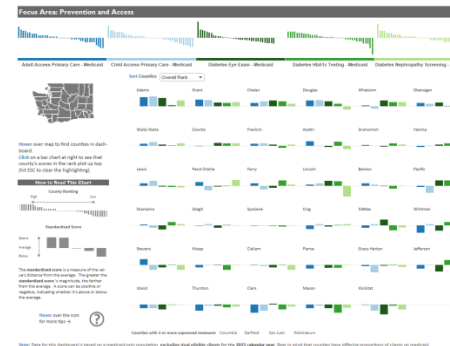

Future releases of the dashboards will contain “refreshed” data, additional measures, and dashboard features. Here’s a closer look at each dashboard...

POPULATION EXPLORER

This dashboard shows the number of Medicaid members living in the state of Washington. You can filter on ACH, county, adult/child, gender, race, ethnicity, and language.

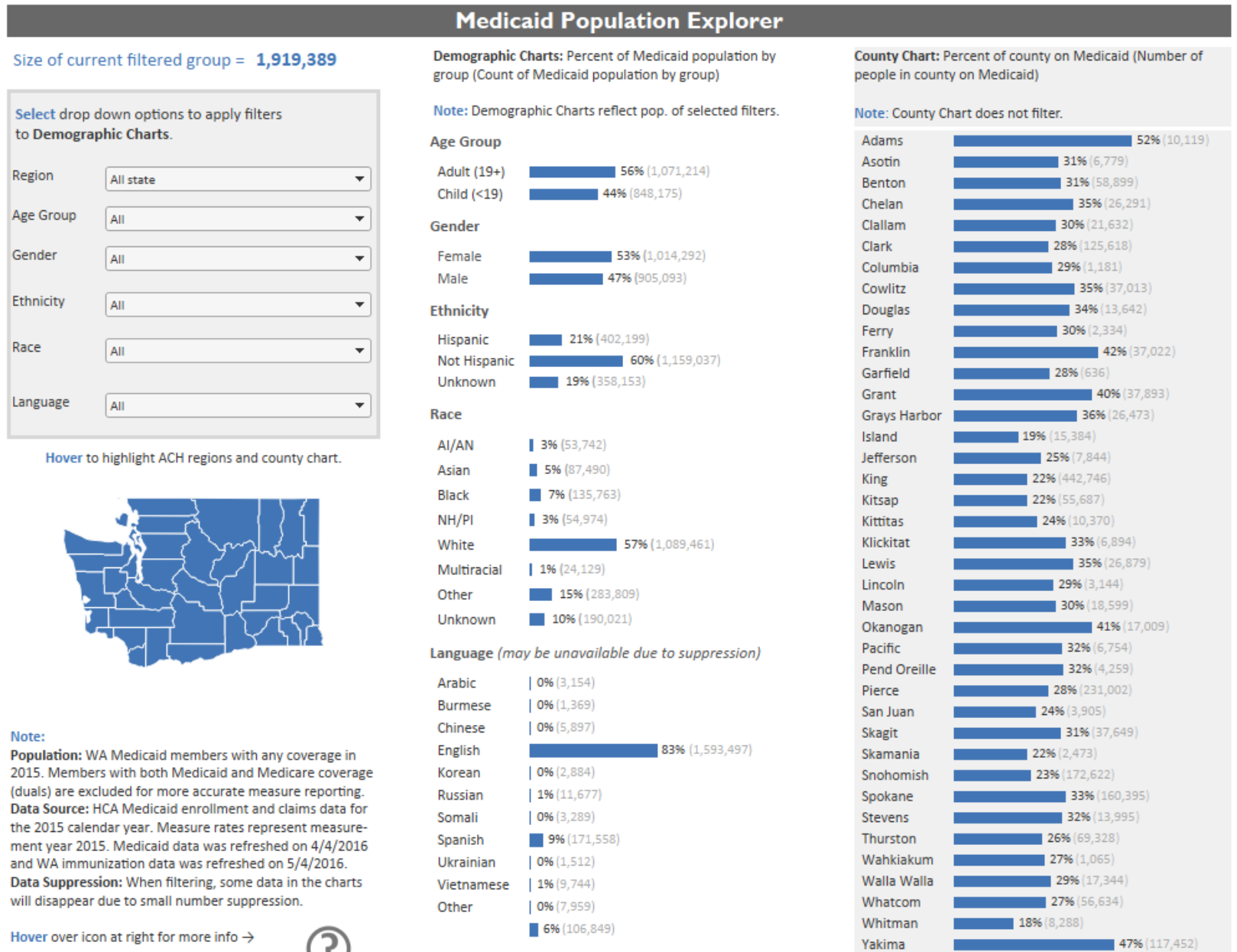
What kind of questions can this dashboard answer?

Examples:

How many Hispanic children covered by Medicaid live in Yakima County? How does that compare to other counties?

- or -

What percent of the population in our county or ACH region is covered by Medicaid?



MEASURE EXPLORER

This dashboard shows measure rates by geographic region (ACH, county) and demographics (adult/child, gender, race, ethnicity, language). Combine filters to see measure rates for specific populations.

Measure Explorer: Adults' Access to Preventive/Ambulatory Health Services - Medicaid

Adults' Access to Preventive/Ambulatory Health Services - Medicaid

Measure Definition: The percentage of members 20 years and older who had an ambulatory or preventive care visit in the measurement year. Derived from WA HCA Medicaid administrative data for measurement year 2015 using HEDIS 2016 Technical Specifications.

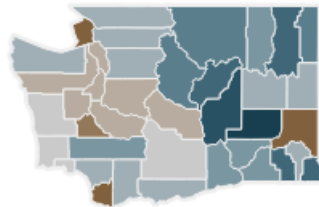

Population: WA Medicaid members with any coverage in 2015. Members with both Medicaid and Medicare coverage (duals) are excluded for more accurate measure reporting.

Data Source: HCA Medicaid enrollment and claims data for the 2015 calendar year. Measure rates represent measurement year 2015. Medicaid data was refreshed on 4/4/2016 and WA immunization data was refreshed on 5/4/2016.

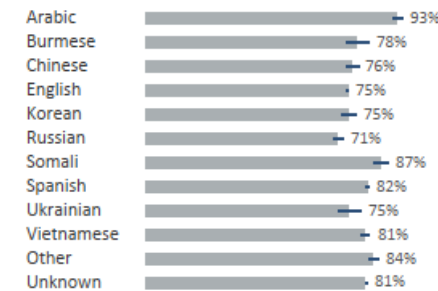

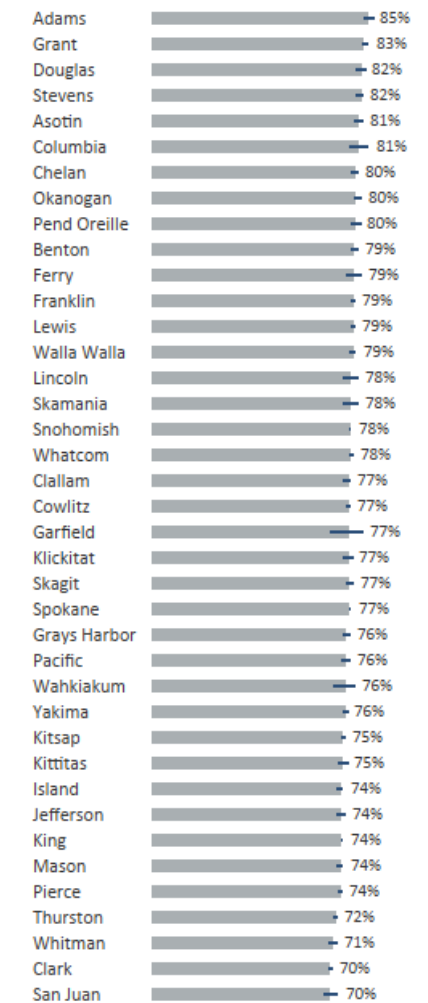

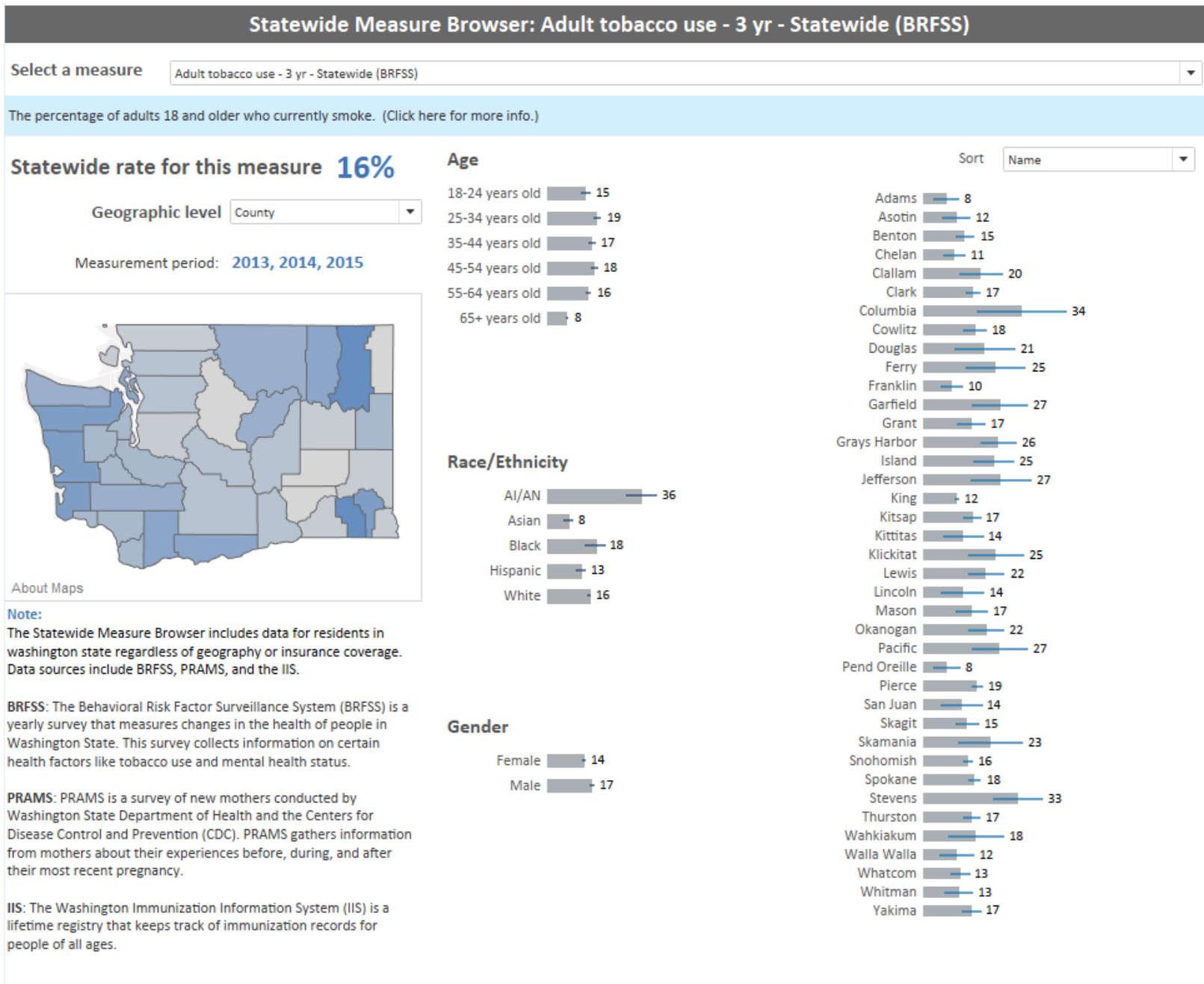

MEASURE BROWSER

This dashboard shows population health measure rates – regardless of insurance type - by geographic region (ACH, county) and statewide demographics (age group, gender, race/ethnicity).

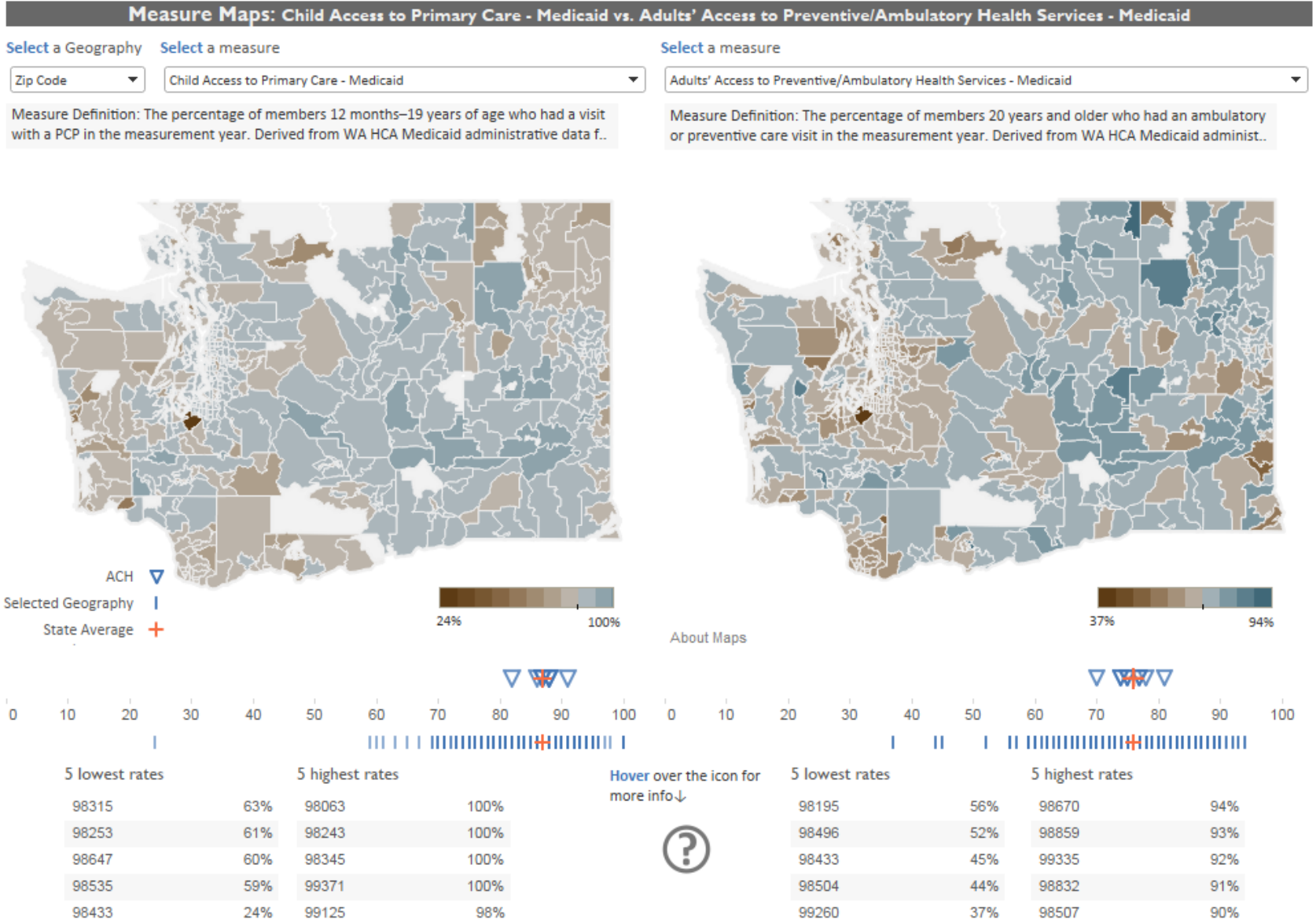

MEASURE MAPS

This dashboard enables you to explore and compare measure rates for different geographic regions (ACH, county, zip code, school district,



What kind of questions can this dashboard answer?

Are the top 5 lowest county rates of child PCP use the same as the top 5 lowest county rates of child immunizations?

-or-

Which zip codes in my region have the lowest rates of health care use?

Note: Medicaid Measures: Data for this dashboard is based on a Medicaid-only population for people with any coverage in 2015. Measure rates represent 2015 calendar year. Data was refreshed on 4/4/2016.
Immunization Measures: Data for immunization measures are from the WA State Immunization Information System and can include anyone in county population (not limited to Medicaid data). WA immunization data was refreshed on 5/4/2016. Immunization measures are only available at county level.

MEASURE SETS

This dashboard compares county performance on multiple measures at once. It visually graphs a standardized score for each county's rate, showing you the county rate's distance from the state average.

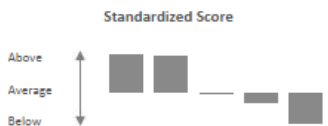

How to Read This Chart



The standardized score is a measure of the value's distance from the average. The greater the standardized score's magnitude, the farther from the average. A score can be positive or negative, indicating whether it's above or below the average.

Note: Data for this dashboard is based on a medicaid-only population, excluding dual eligible clients for the 2015 calendar year. Bear in mind that counties have differing proportions of clients on medicaid.

The third release of the Healthier Washington Dashboard will occur in March 2017. Each dashboard includes a Version History tab that includes information about changes made for each release, such as new measures, new functionality, or corrections.

- Diagnosis rates for depression, asthma, and diabetes

Dashboard reflects Medicaid Claims data for the 2015 calendar year, pulled on April 4, 2016.
Additionally, this version includes calendar year 2015 data from the Washington Immunization Information System. Data was pulled on May 4th, 2016.
This first version of the dashboard was built under Tableau Desktop 9.2.
