### Michael updates:

#### Crisis Response Improvement Strategy (CRIS) committee

- Selected CRIS Committee Members have been contacted and have scheduled introductory calls with the contractor (HMA).
- The first CRIS committee meeting will be held on Thursday, September 30, from 9 a.m. to noon.
- All CRIS committee meetings are open to the public.

  - HCA is currently reviewing applications and fiscal documents.
  - Award letters are expected to go out on Friday, October 1. with funding disbursed by Friday, October 8.



### Congratulations WISe team!

- The <u>TR v. Birch and Clintsman case</u> was dismissed with prejudice on Thursday, September 7.
  - The case cannot be revived and there will no longer be attorney oversight of Wraparound with Intensive Services (WISe).
  - The case was filed in 2009 and led to the creation of WISe which now serves more than 6,000 individuals a year, across the state.
  - HCA would like to recognize and celebrate all of the hard work and success that so many of you have put into the creation, iterations, and development of WISe over the last 12 years.
- As part of the dismissal, HCA will focus on three areas over the next two years:
  - Mobile crisis
  - WISe interest lists
  - Transition age youth
