SUBJECT: Update To Health Technology Assessment Topic Selection, 2025

Hip surgery for femoroacetabular impingement syndrome (FAI) was reviewed by the Health Technology Clinical Committee (HTCC) in 2011 and rereviewed in 2019. Multiple literature searches were completed since the original review to monitor for new evidence. Recently, new evidence is available that could change the policy. I have selected this topic for rereview by the HTCC.

As the Director of the Health Care Authority, I select technologies for review by the HTCC in consultation with participating agencies and the Committee itself (70.14 RCW). Technologies are selected for rereview when there is new information that could change a previous determination.

Upon publication of this notice to rereview FAI, a 30-day comment period will begin whereby any interested person or group may provide information to be considered in the review of the selected topic.
