Practice Transformation Support Hub

Healthier Washington seeks to raise the quality of life in our state by helping Washingtonians have the best health they can regardless of their income, education or background.

Healthier Washington will support transformation of the health delivery system through investment in knowledge, training and tools that effectively coordinate care, promote community linkages, and promote transition to value-based payment models.

The Washington State Department of Health oversees the Practice Transformation Support Hub. The intent of the Hub is to build upon the excellent support already available in many areas throughout Washington by coordinating practice transformation efforts and sharing resources where possible.

The goal of the Hub is to help providers:

- Integrate physical and behavioral health.
- Move from volume to value-based care.
- Improve population health through clinical community linkages.

What kind of support will the Hub offer?

Stakeholders and partners throughout the state have helped Healthier Washington develop a vision that aligns practice transformation initiatives, strategies and priorities with their local needs.

- The Hub will convene a Web-Based Resource Portal for primary and behavioral health care providers.
- Regional Health Connectors will serve as brokers of practice transformation activities. The Connectors will assess needs, provide technical assistance, and coordinate referrals to coaching, facilitation and training services that will address practices' learning priorities.
- Practice Coaching, Facilitation and Training services will advance whole-person care, improve population health, and lower health care costs.
