


Background



Mental Health Assessment for Young Children (MHAYC)

- Mental health assessments for children birth through age 5, Apple Health will:
- Allow reimbursement for:
 - Multi-session assessments
 - Provider travel to home and community settings
- Require providers to:
 - Use the DC:0-5™

Priority 2: Ensure equitable access to developmentally appropriate IECMH services for young children

In October 2025, HCA released new guidance on reimbursement for mental health services with children residing with their parents in residential substance use treatment.

Managed care organization (MCO) contracts were updated to clarity Early Supports for Infants & Toddlers (ESIT) services, as well as requiring more accessible & updated IECMH information.

Priority 5: Strengthen cross-system alignment to achieve integrated whole person care for young children & their families

Sister-state agencies hosted the first in-person PIE convening in 2024, focused on collaboration and strengthening the PIE system of care.

HCA and our partners are working to intentionally align efforts to prioritize IECMH in the state


